BRANTOME, a £100,000 horse, and his travelling companion, Voute Celeste, who may clash afresh tomorrow with his recent French conqueror, Son D'Love, are the first arrivals at Ascot of a batch of thoroughbreds whose combined value, to put it at the very lowest estimate, must be half a million pounds. They will be racing for over £70,000 in stakes.

Osway Plans

I GATHER that Osway will definitely run for the yearling race on Wednesday. His Grace, Prince the Fifth, and Black Speck in the Coventry Stakes, which is also decided tomorrow.

Orwell never met with defeat as a juvenile after failure in his Epsom debut, and a same optimistic view is taken in the case of Osway.

I hope Golden Marlet is fit enough again to run in the Chesham Stakes on Wednesday, and Vanbrugh could wait to take on early fillers like Tetrazzino and Heron.

He stayed on well to beat Princess Faugency-Lucinge's Ping Pong by a length. The well-fancied Maudslayi, with C. Elliott riding, finished third, a length and a half behind. Pearlweed is engaged in the Doncaster St. Leger.

The winner was a comparative outsider. The Tote dividend returned seventy-four francs fifty centimes to a five-franc stake—oddly the approximate 100-7 against. Semblait was the winning jockey.
