Light Brocade at Her Best Again

TO-DAY'S BIG RACE

CAMPANULA duly competed the classic "C" double by winning the One Thousand Guineas at Newmarket yesterday. Like Colombo, she won by a length and, although in her case there was never much doubt about the result when she tackled Light Brocade, her behaviour at the gate caused much uneasiness.

The favourite was cool enough in the parade ring, and there was no fuss and bother while she was being saddled. On reaching the starting gate, however, she was no longer the perfect little lady. Instead of lining up with the others, she showed a marked disinclination to face the tapes. Backing away and prouetting round, she caused a delay that seemed longer than five minutes to a crowd full of anxiety that she might be left.

No More Thrills

Eventually Harry Wragg, who had been drawn No. 2, took her to the outside of the field, and Captain Allison effected a good start. Campanula was not so quickly into her stride as Light Brocade or her stable companion, Honey Buzzard, but they had scarcely gone half the journey before she was in front, and there she remained to the finish to cut out any further thrills.

Light Brocade returned to her two-year-old form in finishing second. A fortnight ago she had been last of seven, because of that lapse she was not nearly such a popular "place" choice as her stable companion Spend a Penny. The latter justified herself in getting third, but she was no danger to either Campanula or Light Brocade. The others, as I feared, failed to stay, and it is going to be difficult to find one to beat the winner in the Oaks.

433 to 1 Winner

A real Newmarket surprise—and a pleasant one for the few who found the winner on the tote—was the victory of Watchdog in the Denston Plate. The youngster was among the 20 to 1 others in the ring, but his tote backers received £43 9s. for each 2s. staked to win and £6 1s. 6d. for a place—odds of 433 to 1 and nearly 60 to 1 respectively. It was almost a last-stride win, as Visionary and Compote were fighting it out when Watchdog came on the scene to get up on the post.

Another outsider to gain a narrow victory was Galvani, who just squeezed home in the Brinkley Welter from Bleu de Roi and Wantalot. The latter was favourite, as he had been for the corresponding race a year ago, but there was little in it between Richards's mount and Conversion, who ran well on the worst side of the course. Galvani "paid" slightly over 25 to 1 on the tote against the s.p. of 100 to 7.

The spring handicap series is resumed to-day at Hurst Park, where Fonab is to attempt

With better luck in the draw he would have been closer than he was in the Newbury Cup, and the shorter distance here is certainly in his favour.

Ideal for Alluvial

Alluvial, too, will find this an ideal journey, and I am warned that Mr. J. B. Joel's horse is going to be a big danger to them all. Mancuvre, who has had a special preparation for the race at Middleham, is out to prove that Light Sussex is not the only cock of the north, and Pricket, Ole King Sole and Shrewton are very much alive. It will be gathered that Fonab has plenty to do, but in an open race I cannot find one I like better.

Her Eminence, a consistent filly last year, should give Harry Wragg another victory in the Paradise Stakes, and he may also find third time lucky on Theo in the Claremont Plate. Knighted, with two victories to his credit, is an obvious danger in the latter race.
