Young Lover May Give **Umidwar Pointer**

FINAL acceptances for the Derby will be published in the Daily Mirror tomorrow, and from what I can gather there will be some twenty "dangers to Colombo" for the bookmakers to get busy with when the card is called over in the evening. Last year, when there were twentyfour runners, Hyperion credited Lord Derby with £9,836, so if an owner takes what appears a forlorn hope against Colombo his £100 entrance fee also gives him nearly a 100 to 1 chance without a bet.

Beckhampton's problem is to be solved by a full-dress rehearsal on Saturday, when Easton, Lo Zingaro and Medieval Knight are to be tried over the full course. Donoghue, and probably R. Dick, will join Richards in the gallop, and on the result will depend how many of them will be started at Epsom. It will be a busy day for Donoghue, as he has engagements to fulfil at Doncaster in the afternoon. But Steve is an old hand at flying, and no doubt often recalls the aeroplane trip to Beckhampton which prefaced his Derby victory on Captain Cuttle.

Berestoi Out

Berestoi, regarded as the chief hope of the north before he failed to beat Autumn at Manchester, will not appear among the acceptors. His absence will leave Nevett without a ride, and if Pink Wings stays away the only northern "actor" in the race will be J. Taylor, who has been engaged to ride Mrs. Raphael's 100 to 1 chance, Hornsey Rise.

Bondsman, Valerius and Hornsey Rise—three definite outsiders—were the only horses to do long work at Newmarket yesterday. Umidwar, along with his three stable companions who will accompany him to Epsom, were cantering, and Colombo was confined to six-furlong work with Red Horizon. No doubt all concerned with the favourite will be glad when the Derby is over, but none of the humans will be as pleased as Red Horizon.

York Pointer

We should get some idea of Umidwar's real form to-day when Young Lover makes his first appearance in the Yorkshire Cup. Sir Alfred Butt's colt took part in the mile and a haif gallop in which the Derby colt went so well on Saturday, and it follows that confidence in the Aga Khan's chief hope will increase if Young Lover wins to-day.


At this time last year I had great hopes about Young Lover himself as a Derby horse, but the hard ground left him at a big disadvantage. Subsequent events have proved that he would not have beaten Hyperion in any case, but they have also shown Young Lover to be a really good horse when the conditions suit him. As they bid fair to do so to-day he may come back with a victory at the expense of Brunswick and Apple Peel, both of which are well fancied.

The North Country scored an even bigger triumph when three youngsters from different Yorkshire stables occupied the leading positions in the Zetland Plate. The winner was Blue Charm, who came with the reputation of

being the best two-year-old trained by Dobson Peacock. He certainly won like a good one. Confetti colt was going as well as anything a little more than a furlong out when Blue Charm drew right away and beat the challenging Guildhall without an effort.

Newmarket had begun well with Murano in the Glasgow Handicap, and further successes came the way of headquarters with Damascus and Haytime. Like the first winner, Damascus was ridden by W. Rickaby, and, as in the selling race, he was all out to keep the lead in a great finish. Bidou, although ridden for a burst of speed at the finish, found the mile just too far, and shared third place with Alexander, who continues to be a disappointment to Lord Harewood.

Gatacre may be one of the best-looking horses in training, but he is also one of the most disappointing. In a small field he was a warm favourite for the Tadcaster Stakes and went' under once again without ever presenting the slightest danger. The race was won by Haytime, who led all the way to hold off another disappointing sort in Vallip, who at least gets near if not quite there.

Richards' Half Century

Gordon Richards rode two winners at Bath to bring his total to fifty for the season. His first victory was scored on Amity gelding in the last stride from Silver Somme filly, and the half century went up with Sharpshooter in the Tradesmen's Handicap. The latter is trained by F. Templeman, who invariably has a winner or two at Bath, and may carry on the good work with Milldoria in the Weston Stakes to-day.

Richards also went very near to winning the Spring Handicap on Flower of Zion, who was enly caught close home by Pharacre. The latter is the first winner sent out by Fred Butters since he took charge of the Kingsclere establishment and it was the first time that the Stewards' Cup winner had run since last October. Flying Spear II gave a disappointing display, but Shell of Gold ran well and her turn should come again shortly.
