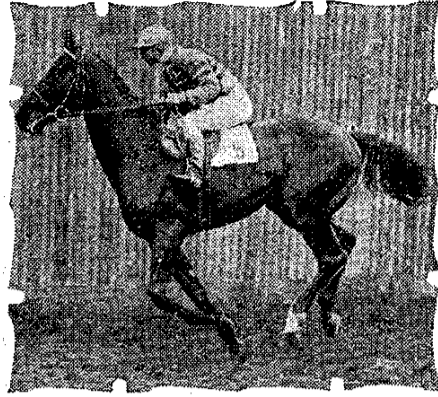
We should get some idea of Umidwar's real form to-day when Young Lover makes his first appearance in the Yorkshire Cup...
