WOMAN'S TWO LONG SHOTS

Favourite Shines in a Long Gallop

YORK CUP SURPRISE

COLOMBO and twenty-one others make up the final list of acceptances for the Derby. Some such number had been anticipated, and as no doubt a few will drop out before the day of the race, it must be the smallest field since Blenheim won in 1930, and there may even be fewer runners than at any time since Grand Parade, in the Colombo colours, beat a dozen rivals in 1919.

Curiously enough both those races were won by the least fancied of two stable companions, but although that can happen again so far as the Aga Khan is concerned, it has always been Colombo or nothing for Lord Glanely. The colt had another mile and a half gallop at Newmarket yesterday, joined this time by Steady Flame from Digby's stable, and Winstep, in addition to his now constant companion Red Horizon.

How he treated them is best described by a photograph of the finish of the gallop on page 16. Of course, any horse with the slightest pretensions to Derby honours, would be expected to do the same, but the point that matters about these gallops is that Colombo keeps his action right through. There is rarely much the matter with the stamina of a horse that can do that, whatever the conditions.

Meanwhile, it looks as if the hard ground is going to rob Frank Butters of one of his four acceptors. The one on the "doubtful" list is Achtenan, who is suffering from sore shins. As the easy conqueror of Medieval Knight at Kempton, Mr. Lant's colt was well in the picture as a "likely outsider" but it is doubtful if the Epsom course would show him to such good advantage.

Happily all goes well with Umidwar, the main hope of the stable. He was given another good mile and a half gallop yesterday, this time with Felicitation, who could not shake him off. Alishah also took part in the spin, but dropped out after going a mile. Badruddin was "otherwise engaged," assisting Light Brocade and Spend-a-Penny in their work for the Oaks.

The withdrawal of Democrat leaves Mrs. Walter Raphael with the distinction of being the only woman owner represented in the race. She has caused a mild surprise by leaving in Fleetfoot as well as Hornsey Rise, but it is a forlorn hope that either will get so near as did Louviers when her husband's horse went under to King Edward's Minor, let alone emulate Tagalie.

Luck in the matter of the weather was not with Young Lover in his attempt to win the Yorkshire Cup yesterday. Instead of the yielding going he so strongly prefers, the ground had dried up so much that it was decided not to start Bonny Brighteyes, and one became merely hopeful about the prospects of Sir Alfred Butt's colt.

In the circumstances he put up quite a good performance in finishing third to Within the Law and Brunswick, and I have not dispaired of seeing him win another good race when the conditions are right. Within the Law was better handicapped here than he had been at Manchester last week, and he likes firm going much better than the sort he found at Castle Irwell.

Perryman was in the limelight for most of the afternoon. Before his third on Young Lover he had beaten the Middleham filly, Liberty End, on Valkyrie in the Micklegate Plate, and finished second on Maid of Africa

to Buhardo in the Eglinton Stakes. Half an hour after the big race he was on another winner when Pampas Grass proved a neck too good for Tribulation, and left us wondering whether this winner or Blue Charm is the best youngster in the north.

Cliff Richards, riding for Blagrave, twice defeated his brother Gordon at Bath. In the Beaufort Handicap he was successful on Golden Earl against Hellenize, and in the Kelston Handicap on Man of Property he finished a length in front of Mr. Pitman.

Small Fields

Fields will be on the small side in most of the races at York today, and that for the Great Northern Handicap will be particularly disappointing. Apparently Overall, like Robber Chief, who was just behind him at Manchester, will not be saddled, and it looks as if Meldrum has a good chance of opening his winning account for Boyd Rochfort. Play On is the danger, and a big one at that.

Manton will have two well fancied runners in Monkshead and Law Maker, the latter of which might now be among the dangers to Colombo if Lord Astor's Derby luck were not so atrocious. From all accounts, he is nicely forward in condition, and that being the case Potiphar should find it difficult to give him 14lb. in the Sledmere Plate.

FROM THE STABLES

Manton-Monkshead (2.5) is well fancied at York. Law Maker (2.40) should win at the same meeting. Beresfell (3.30) is regarded good at Salisbury. Rockhampton-Skilligalee (3.30) will require beating at Salisbury. Thernidor (4.0), a clever winner at Hurst Park, is expected to score in the Wiltshire Plate.

Ogbourne-Hidalgo (4.0) should win at Salisbury. Tetrema (3.50) is also fancied. Lambourn-Venery (2.5), Irongrey (2.40) at York, and Puck-Bar (1.45) at Salisbury are fancied.
