BIG TASK FOR COROADO

Test for Stayers at Newmarket To-day RICHARDS'S 99

THIRTEEN horses have gone out of the Stewards' Cup at the acceptance stage, leaving twenty-nine "possibles" for the big sprint at Goodwood on Tuesday week. Pharoac can attempt to win the race for the second year in succession, but instead of 7st. 5lb. he now has 7st. 10lb. Solenoid, successful with 7st. 10lb. two years ago and third with 9st. 7lb. last year, has accepted with 9st. 4lb., but even with this poundage it is not too much to say that he will develop into a fancied candidate.

Coroado is at the head of the handicap with 9st. 8lb., and at first glance this appears to be a formidable task. The son of Colorado, however, has been in brilliant form this season with a dead-heat with Sudan in the Salford Borough Handicap at Manchester, followed by successes in the Voltiger Handicap at York, Wokingham Stakes at Ascot, and July Cup at Newmarket. Spirituelle II, who had earned a penalty, has disappeared, but Clustine, a winner at Lingfield last Saturday, remains to do duty. Another one missing is Flying Spear II. Old Riley, Crumpets, Morfar, North Devon, and the Old Pretender have all accepted, and altogether there is the material for a most interesting race.

Flying Spear II's Win
 Flying Spear II was an easy winner of the July Handicap at Newmarket yesterday, but, as already stated, he is not to run at Goodwood. Other Stewards' Cup horses, in Pharoac and Sublime Prince, were among his victims, Pharoac finishing fifth and Sublime Prince seventh. Flying Spear II was quickly into his stride and made all the running to win from Alexander. Woodhouse was prominent all the way, and it was only close home that Hardy deprived him of third place. Mr. C. Jarvis gave 800 guineas for Flying Spear after he had won at Newbury last month, so that he all but recovered the outlay by this success.

It was interesting to note the day's racing opening with an apprentice race with "Entrance Free." It attracted nine runners, and although races confined to apprentices are not easy to size up, backers did the right thing in making Typhoon favourite. Mildendale, ably ridden by D. Sutherland, came with a strong run in the last furlong, but had no chance of catching E. Sadgrove on Typhoon.

Perryman's Double
 Cornered, with Carstake in the saddle, was an odds-on chance for the Zetland Stakes, but met the fate of so many other hot favourites recently, for he was beaten into third place by Bridge Law and Wing Commander. Manhu was in the lead to begin with, but about a quarter of a mile from home Bridge Law took up the running, and Perryman easily held off Harry Wragg on Wing Commander. Perryman also met with success on Plint Man in the Two-Year-Old Sale Stakes. It was expected that Berobos would give Gordon Richards his hundredth winner in this race, but he was beaten a length.

Lord Derby won the Kirtling Claiming and Selling Plate with Clematis, who was on offer at 100 to 8, but backers were well on the mark in the Falmouth Stakes. Zelina and Mis Tor headed the market, and after an interesting race the Manton filly defeated Donoghue's mount by a length and a half.

Race for Stayers
 Many smart stayers are engaged in the Summer Handicap at Newmarket to-day. Northumberland Plate rivals in Son of Mint, Within-the-Law, Roi de Paris, Whiteplains, Apple Peel, and Lament, can meet again, and of this little

bunch many would give Lament another chance if started.
 Lament, however, is a doubtful starter, and in the circumstances Silver Jubilee has obvious claims. At Sandown Park last month Lord Howard de Walden's horse was a clever winner of the Claremont Handicap, and he has only to reproduce that form to score again. This horse is improving with every gallop, and is a force to be reckoned with.

Northallerton found a mile too far for him when beaten at headquarters a fortnight ago, and over a furlong less I give him a good chance in the Histon Handicap. All the same, I scarcely think he will give the weight to Love Tie, who was in a close finish when third in a similar race at the last meeting.

The return to a shorter distance than she essayed at Salisbury gives Poet's Pride a sound chance in the Somerset Handicap at Bath, but as she gets only 11b. from Shrewsbury Boy I doubt that she will be quite good enough. Templeman's colt showed his best form over a mile in the Esher Cup at Sandown, and a fourth in that race looks good enough for a first here.
