La Gaiete Too Good for Caretta

HARDY'S UPSET

A SERIES of surprises made Goodwood really glorious for the bookmakers yesterday. Hardy began them in the very first race, but even if the colt started at twice the odds offered against La Gaiete, the latter's defeat of Caretta in the Molecomb Stakes was the result that caused perhaps the biggest shock of the four days.

Beckhampton has surely never had such a dismal Goodwood as it has experienced this week. The Aga Khan had beaten his champion colt when Theft upset Ben Marshall on the first day. In turn Lo Zingaro and Holyrood were foiled by Umidwar and Badruddin in the same colours, and it was rubbing it in with a vengeance when La Gaiete upset Caretta, who was regarded by many good judges as a second Myrobella.

Still the Best

Still, if the prize went to the Aga Khan's youngster, the honours were undoubtedly won by Caretta, who remains for most of us the best filly seen so far this season. She was conceding 14lb. to each of her rivals, and it was only in keeping with the ill-luck attending everything from Beckhampton just now that she should find one among them a head too good in a great finish.

Another favourite to go under by a similarly narrow margin to a 10 to 1 chance was Wychwood Abbot, who lost the Chesterfield Cup to Alcazar. Luck was on the side of the winner in this case, as Wychwood Abbot appeared certain to win when he swerved to the left close home. Highlander narrowly lost third place to Celestial City, and near at hand was Sol-fatara, whose turn should surely come shortly.

Bidou Fails

Bidou cut a poor figure for a good favourite in the Chichester Stakes, for after holding a nice place in the early stages he died away to finish nearer last than first. Flying Spear II lasted much longer; indeed he did not look like being caught until his stride began to shorten in the last furlong. Then Hardy came on the scene and finishing much the stronger of the pair won cleverly.

Between the successes of Hardy and Alcazar, Bright Bird justified the odds laid on his chance in the Gordon Stakes, and after La Gaiete's surprise, Zelina found an easy task in the Nassau Stakes. Although the opposition was of a moderate character, Bright Bird's performance was quite a good one considering that he carried 9st. 10lb and easily held off Pharillon who was receiving 21lb.

Public Form Best

Once again public form proved better than private reputation when Apollo beat Veldschoen in the Findon Stakes. Tetrema was an unexpected favourite to wind up the meeting, but the Ogbourne filly was never in the picture, and Apollo, whose consistency deserved a winning turn, scored cleverly from Veldschoen. Press Cutting was also well among the also rans, so that the eclipse of Beckhampton was complete.

Alexandra Park and Chpstow join Catterick to-day as a prelude in the rush of holiday meetings. The Welsh fixture extends over Monday, when there will also be racing at Sandown, Birmingham and Ripon, to say nothing of the first jumping meeting of the season at Newton Abbot. G. Richards will be riding at Chpstow to-day, and as a change of luck is due for the champion, it may come on the course where he rode eleven winners off the reel last year.

BEST FROM THE BOOK BLUE DOMINO

has been going well in gallops, and should be noted for the Barmet Maiden Plate at Alexandra Park.

Dawson Waugh is sending his recent winners, Blue Domino and Quillon, to Alexandra Park, and it is quite on the cards that both will carry on the good work by scoring again. Quillon has top weight to carry in the Metropolitan Handicap, but the task should not be beyond him; indeed, there is nothing I like better on the day's card. Golden Earl is nicely treated, and should finish in the first three.

Mumtaz Begum looks like carrying on the good work for the Aga Khan in the Maiden Plate. At the moment five furlongs is quite as far as she likes to go, but she has fine speed, and the conditions are all in her favour at present. Sea Joy's consistency deserves a winning turn, which may come in the Holloway Handicap if she can beat Meritondy.

DAVIS REGAINS LEAD

Davis, the British champion, regained his lead by outpunting Waller Lindrum by 2.318 points to 1,400 in their match, which was continued at Sydney yesterday, states Reuter. Davis now leads by 878. Steady and consistent play enabled Davis to go ahead. His best breaks were 477, 425, 371, 281 and 270. Lindrum's play was spasmodic during the afternoon session, but he improved in the evening to make three good breaks of 703, 205 and 204. Closing scores were: Davis 9,415, Lindrum (in play) 8,537.
