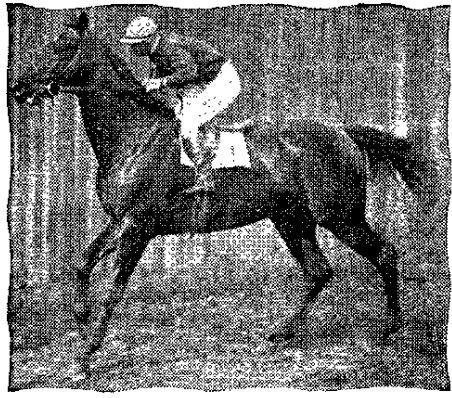


YOUNG TRAINER'S BIG TRIUMPH

Form Vindicated by Victory of Wychwood Abbot

RACE OF MANY THRILLS

Farewell Victory of Felicitation in Jockey Club Cup To-day?

FORM vindicated itself almost to the ounce at Newmarket yesterday when Wychwood Abbot completed the great autumn double by winning the Cambridgeshire on such another day as spoiled the Cesarewitch as a spectacle. It was raw cold and damp, and considering the fortunes at stake on the race the attendance was most disappointing.

But what a race it was! The bare result tells Wychwood Abbot won by half a length from Commander III with Highlander beaten a short head for second place. How many holders of sweepstake tickets for half a dozen or more of the others were thrilled with the prospects of a cheque for £30,000 before Perryman delivered his final dash that put the result beyond question in the last half furlong?

Spend a Penny Favourite

Grand Rounds, Rentenmark, Celadon, The Blue Boy, British Quota and Flamenco, besides the placed horses, all had their chance coming down Bushes Hill. The only one of the horses in the front rank of the betting whose chance was negligible at this point was Spend a Penny—and this filly was the one in which chief hopes were reposed at the start.

Grand Rounds was the leader at the foot of the hill, but by that time it was apparent that Perryman had been able to ride the race that suits Wychwood Abbot best. He was well placed for the final burst, and when it came any hope that remained for Grand Rounds was speedily eclipsed. Highlander, on the stand side, and Commander III, near the centre, stayed on to keep the interest alive, but we did not have to wait until the numbers went up to know which had won.

Perryman's First

Wychwood Abbot's victory was a crowning triumph for Perryman and incidentally it was his first success in the race. Next year he will embark on a new step in his career as first jockey to Lord Derby. For a man of his weight he has had a remarkable season, and speaking off hand I should say that no rider at any time has been more successful with two-year-olds—to my mind the supreme art of jockeyship.

Ted Leader, who trains the winner, is a nephew of Colledge Leader, with whom Perryman will be chiefly associated next season. Leader, who rode Sprig when he won the Grand National, got his chance when his uncle went to Stanley House at the beginning of the year, and he has certainly made the most of it. One thing is certain and that is that there will be no pleasant memories of this year's autumn double for the bookmakers.

Fine Jockeyship

Nothing gives Gordon Richards greater pleasure than a win or two on big days. Your casual racegoer knows more about jockeys than horses, so Richards is the inspiration to the great majority who go racing only once in a while. As on Cesarewitch day, he gave them a good start yesterday, and to do so rode a typical never-say-die race that enabled Vermeil II to get home by a short head.

A young jockey we are going to hear a lot more about is Humphrey Foster, who rode an old man's race to win the Houghton Handicap on Fair Abness. Foster has been carefully tutored by George Digby, and at nineteen can go to scale at under 7st. On Fair Abness he showed appreciation of both pace and distance, and whatever he does in the future he is unlikely to ride a better race.

Applan Way, Gordon Richards's mount in the New Nursery, was beaten a furlong from home, and after Dines looked like winning on Four Bells, Auld Reekie challenged and landed a 10 to 1 chance for Dobson Peacock's stable. But if Richards failed here, he rewarded his followers by winning the Scarborough Stakes on Feather Boy. Long odds were bet on Cecil, but judging by the cheers that greeted

Gordon on his return not everybody regarded him as the "outsider of three."

It looks like being another great day for the Aga Khan to-day. Felicitation runs his last race in the Jockey Club Cup, and it is long odds on him finishing a spectacular career with a victory. Hairan appears an equally good thing for the Dewhurst Stakes, and Alishah, in spite of his weight, has a first-rate chance of winning the Free Handicap.

There is a big tip in the town for John James in the handicap, and remembering the promise shown by this colt early in the season, I can picture him being a danger. After all, however, he will be up against a rival bordering on classic form, and this sort have a knack of overcoming handicaps imposed by the difference of weight.

Smoke Screen, with the choice of more than one engagement at the meeting, will be worth serious consideration if saddled for the Richmond Nursery. Fox Lair, a clever winner last time out, is another with a good chance, and yet another is Inflation. Obviously it is a very open race, but Inflation, with J. Childs up, looks almost certain to be thereabouts whatever wins.
