BUCKLEIGH WINS CRAVEN STAKES AFTER BEING TAKEN OUT OF THE DERBY

LAST year Colombo started at 100 to 30 on and made a procession of the Craven Stakes. Yesterday the same colours were carried by a really dark horse named Buckleigh, and so little was thought about him that even with Gordon Richards riding the newcomer was allowed to start at 20 to 1. Like Colombo, he won easily, but the simile cannot extend to Epsom. He has already been scratched from the Derby, although still in the Guineas.

It is strange enough to find Gordon Richards on a 20 to 1 winner, and almost unbelievable that a mount of his should be so deserted that the tote could pay a dividend representing odds of 118 to 1.

The whys and wherefores of this strange happening were afterwards explained by Lord Glanely. "Buckleigh had been such a disappointment," he said, "that he was turned out of training last October and only returned in January. Since then he had shown such little promise that I struck him out of all engagements for which there was a forfeit. I ran him to-day because I wanted Gordon Richards's opinion of him."

Zingaro Fails

There was never much doubt about the result from the moment the horses entered the Dip. Going easily, Buckleigh went about his task like an old hand, and strode up the hill in great style.

The much-discussed Zingaro was a big disappointment. A warm favourite at 7 to 4, he had every chance had he been good enough, and I am afraid it must be Robin Goodfellow or nothing for Sir Abe Bailey in the classics. Maltravers failed to stay under his big weight,

but Hindoo Holiday got second—three lengths behind Buckleigh—to tell the tale for his stable companions, Theft, Hairan and Bahram.

Few owners have been so lucky in their Turf bargains as Mr. Chris Jarvis. He gave only 250 guineas for Knighted as a yearling, and was fortunate to keep him at 510 guineas after a selling plate debut at Alexandra Park. After that he won six more races off the reel, including the Fern Hill Stakes at Ascot. The sequence was broken at Hurst Park last November, but in his first attempt as a three-year-old he proved all too good for a big field in the Free Handicap.

Knighted's Fine Speed

Consequential, whose trainer regards him as something more than a good outsider for the Guineas, was favourite in spite of his big weight. He was always among the leading division without being able to improve in the last furlong. Clematis looked very dangerous in the Dip, but Knighted found a burst of speed that was much too good for them all.

Two interesting happenings to-day will be the reappearance of Easton in the Spring Stakes at Lingfield Park and the debut of the tailless colt, Coron, in the Abberley Plate at Worcester. Easton looks a good thing, but the same cannot be said about the two-year-old until we have seen him.

Frank Butters had two winners yesterday in Near Relation and New Radnor, and it is on the cards that the good work will be carried on by Dornoch in the Lingfield Spring Plate. Acrostic and Polly Jerome have good chances on their Lincoln form, and recent running gives Sea Pride, Belrue and Master Joe bright prospects at Worcester.
