

EASTON GIVES BECKHAMPTON A START

EASY VICTORY AT LINGFIELD

More Long Tote Odds for Outsiders

EASTON won its first race of the season with the best horse in the stable at Lingfield yesterday when Easton landed the odds in the Spring Stakes. There was only a neck in it, but the margin might have been extended had it been necessary. Moreover, it has to be remembered that Sea Bequest, who received 24lb., had enjoyed the benefit of a previous race.

Easton has grown into a fine creature since his three-year-old days. I am told we shall say the same about Windsor Lad when we see him, and another duel between the pair at Epsom will be anticipated as one of the best things in the whole season.

Richards was riding so easily with Sea Bequest in close attendance passing the stands that there were shouts of "Go on" from the ring. His "advisers" had obviously overlooked the fact that mile races finish at the post beyond that used for other races on this course. Easton had a long neck to spare when that goal was reached.

More Long Odds

Outsiders inevitably bring much prominence to the tote as the purveyor of long odds. This time it was Fox who was left out in the cold. He was on an easy winner in Monk's Call in the Surrey Plate, and the few who threw away a trifle on the off-chance, received odds of 140 to 1. With the favourites out of the first three, there was also a fat dividend for the placed horses, of which Demigod the Second returned odds at the rate of 95 to 1.

Mr. Fred Sedgwick won the Lingfield Spring Plate with a useful youngster in Fondness filly, who, like Rose Bow, the winner of the Oxted Plate, is a daughter of Bold Archer. Dafila filly, the favourite, ran prominently, but from below the distance Fondness filly drew away, and is obviously one to follow in any near at hand engagements.

Quaint Two-Year-Olds

Coron, the two-year-old born without a tail, claimed more attention than any horse that had been in the Worcester paddock for many years. The interest, however, did not extend to the ring, where offers of 100 to 7 did not tempt many backers. In the race he was never prominent, and in a great finish the Newbury winner, Bridge of Avon, lasted long enough to beat Belgrave by a head.

Another quaint two-year-old is Master Joe, whose deformed foot does not affect his racing ability. He ran his fourth race in three weeks in the Selling race and was always going too well for the well-backed Silver Mystery colt. The latter, like Belgrave, is trained by F. Templeman, who had a really unlucky day with Wild Blossom also narrowly beaten.

Apollo is not likely to be saddled. Jack Jarvis will rely on Felswood, who may prove the winner. He is an improved animal from last season.


