

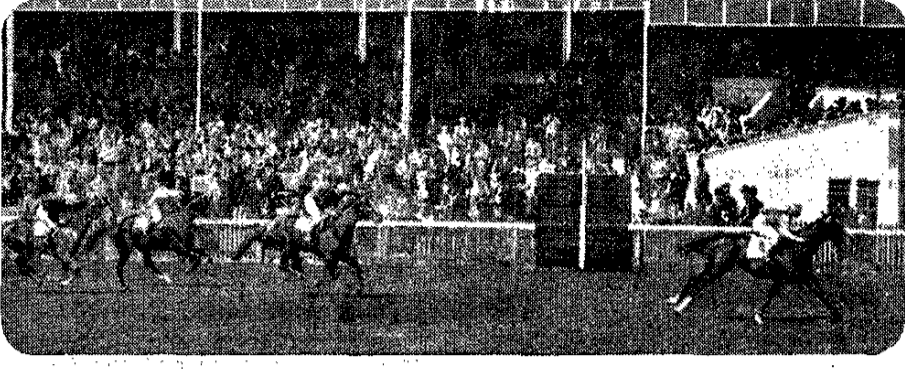

DECISIVE WIN FOR MESA

Caretta Prominent But Fails to Stay TO-DAY'S CUP RACE By BOUVERIE GOOD colts, but very poor fillies, apparently sums up our classic possessions this season. Caretta, outstanding among her sex last year, did manage to get third in the One Thousand Guineas yesterday, but actually she stayed no more than six furlongs, and Mesa, a French filly ridden by W. Johnstone, won very easily indeed from Hyndford Bridge.

France surprised us in this particular race six years ago when Taj Mah scored a similarly easy victory. The surprise was not so great on this occasion, as Mesa was well backed, largely on the assumption that she might stay better than all our fillies. French visitors, however, were by no means unanimous that Mesa would beat her other representative, Corrida, so that picking the right one became more than ever in the nature of a lucky dip.

The queen of the party in the paddock was undoubtedly Caretta. She is surely the most handsome filly in training, and no doubt her appearance finally decided the majority. In the end she was a 9 to 4 chance, with Fox Lair, Corrida, Annabel, Ankaret and Mesa all of a heap, so to speak, at 7 and 8 to 1.

Such betting promised a rare thriller if Caretta did not stay. Instead, Corrida, Annabel and Ankaret never looked like having anything to do with the finish. Fox Lair would probably have been second to Caretta had the race finished at the end of six furlongs. Like the favourite, however, she died away in the last quarter of a mile, and Mesa came through to win very easily from the hard-ridden Hyndford Bridge.

Flamenco, with a 5lb. penalty for his Lincolnshire victory, will be backed to carry on the good work in the Victoria Cup to-day. Class does tell in these handicaps, and I must say that, with the stable still in such good form, I have a wholesome fear of Lord Rosebery's colt with all his weight.

Boethius, for which Harry Wragg has been specially engaged, has made the long journey from Middleham. He is regarded as the best horse trained at that famous quarter at present, and is thought sure to play a leading part in the finish. Shining Tor, Bondsman, Over Coat and Pegasus will all help to make it a thrilling affair, but I have come to the conclusion that the one thing all have to beat is Bow and Arrow.

At the distance of to-day's race it would have been a near thing between Flamenco and Bow and Arrow at Lincoln, where the latter was receiving 12lb. To-day the difference between them is 18lb., and over the slightly shorter journey Bow and Arrow must have a big chance of getting his revenge. Boethius is perhaps the best one for a place.
