SOLITAIRE BIG NORTHERN HOPE

Orsue Scores Under **Difficulties** 

SATYR'S SPRINT

ALL Manchester and most of the North of England is talking of Solitaire as a good thing for the Manchester Cup to-day. On his best form there is no doubt that the Middle-ham horse is well handicapped, but after going very carefully through the race I have come to the conclusion that he is no better "in" than Irongrey, if indeed he is quite so well treated.

Lord Hirst's horse is one of those admirable creatures which never seem to run a bad race. He was too good for Tiberius at level weights on one occasion last year, and in the Free Handicap at the back end gave Fillip 22lb. and ran him to a short head, with Heavy Weight receiving 12lb. half a length away. To-day Fillip receives 14lb. and Heavy Weight only 4lb.

Irongrey has been out twice this season, and on each occasion narrowly beaten. Solitaire has had one race, at Nottingham, where, carrying 1lb. less than Fillip, he was well behind Sir Joshua Reynolds in the Spring Handicap. Great improvement is claimed for the Middleham horse of late; indeed, such is the enthusiasm for Dines's mount that there is a distinct possibility that he will start at a false price.

Short Run-Danger

Bunker, both game and consistent, is the popular Newmarket fancy. It is against him that three-year-olds have a poor record in the race, but worth recalling that Lord Derby's colours were on the last three-year-old winner when Donnithorne was successful in 1912. Bunker, I feel sure, will give a good account of himself to-day, but the one I fear most against Irongrey and Solitaire is Short Run.

It was the original intention that Manton should be represented by Adept as well as Sir Abe Bailey's filly, but apparently a later gallop has caused the revision of those plans. On her last appearance Short Run was a comfortable winner at Newmarket over the distance of to-day's race, so that she has every qualification for the task on hand.

In addition to Irongrey, Lambourn will have several other dangerous candidates during the afternoon. One of them is Roberta, who goes for the Lodge Maiden Plate, and another Escallonia, one of the light weights in the Bury Handicap. A newcomer from the same quarter in Crayon is well spoken of for the Cotton Plate, and might be good enough to win if she can beat Ruth.

# Game Orsue

No better performance has been seen at the meeting than Orsue's game display in the Mark Price Handicap yesterday. While Fogbound, the favourite, had a clear run until well into the straight, Orsue was finding all sorts of trouble. Eventually Harry Wragg brought her to the outside, and, running on with great resolution, she beat Newtown Ford comfortably by a length.

Virgin Queen colt, favourite for the Northern Stakes, met ill-luck of another sort that is rarely overcome in a five furlong race. Not only did he fail to strike off so well as several others, but he appeared to get a bump soon after the start. In any case, however, he might not have beaten the newcomer, Strapeto, who went about her inch in the style of an old hand went about her job in the style of an old hand.

Lord Carnarvon chose the right race for Satyr when he decided to miss Epsom for the Beaufort Handicap. In the ring it was North v. South battle between the top weight and Lotus Eater, but the South had it in the race with the luckless Tetrapod second for the fourth time in succession. Latoi, a stable companion to Solitaire, justified his choice as the best thing of the day in the Irwell Handicap, although he had only a short head to spare over Autumn Tints.
