### Dead-Heaters Meet at Kempton To-day

## TOMMAOK DOUBT

SEVERAL horses from time to time have been favourite for the Cambridgeshire since Pegasus was the first to occupy that position, but it appears unlikely that he will lose his place again after his convincing performance at Newmarket yesterday. Although racing on the worst side of the course, nothing had a chance against him in the last furlong, and Caymanas was beaten decisively by three lengths, with half a dozen other Cambridgeshire horses in the rear.

The big disappointments of the race were Negundo and Badruddin, particularly the French horse, who started a good favourite. At the end of a mile it looked as if Elliott's trip from France would be well worth while. But as soon as Pegasus began to go forward Negundo weakened and finished nearly last.

Badruddin lasted much longer, and it might be unwise to regard the Aga Khan's colt as a hopeless case for the Cambridgeshire. It was the first outing he had had since Goodwood, and a race in public can do more than half a dozen home gallops. Knighted lost several lengths at the start and was out of the race from the rise of the tanes from the rise of the tapes.

#### Tommaok Warning

After the race 100 to 8 was the ruling price against Pegasus for the big race to follow. Gunboat and Caymanas were others backed on the course, but there was nothing doing in connection with the Cesarewitch. Earlier in the week I met people anxious to take anything over 16 to 1 about Tommaok. Those who could not find bookmakers to accommodate them will not be sorry in view of the latest news concerning the Newbury Cup casualty.

Tommaok received several nasty cuts in the mix-up that followed his fall, and although none of them was deep he has not been able to do any serious work since. Richards, who sustained concussion in the tumble, nas so much improved that he will leave hospital for his home to-day.

#### At Kempton To-day

Wychwood Abbot and British Quota, dead-heaters for the Jubilee early in the season, meet again at Kempton to-day in the Duke of York Handicap on terms that suggest that the latter should be first this time if one of the pair is to win. The reason, of course, that the weights favour British Quota to the extent of 5lb. is to be found in the fact that Wychwood Abbot has been successful since, whereas the filly has been beaten four times.

It is probable, however, that the conditions underfoot will have a greater bearing on to-day's result than the mere question of weight. Wychwood Abbot has always done his best when the going has been on the firm side, and the heavy rains of the past few days must impose an additional handicap on the top weights. weights.

### British Quota Preferred

Much as I admire Wychwood Abbot, I doubt in the circumstances if he is quite up to the big task set him to-day. Twenty-nine pounds is a lot of weight to concede to a filly like British Quota, who showed promise of returning to form when third to Almond Hill and Canteener at Derby recently. Plymouth Sound and Pricket look the pick of the others, and although the distance may be full far for Pricket he may manage to run into a place

Abjer looks like the winner of the rich Imperial Produce Stakes on his Doncaster second to Mahmoud, but from all accounts there are at least three stables not scared by the Newmarket colt. One is Manton, with Mendicant Friar, another Middleham, with the newcomer Thankerton, and the other Beckhampton, with Empire Glory, Perhaps the last-named will be the one to make Abjer go all the way.
