## WESTON'S "DESERTED" WINS AT NOTTINGHAM

### Sir Abe Bailey's Luck with Ex-Plater ANOTHER TO-DAY?

WHEN Sir Abe Bailey gave Weston the choice between Doreen Jane and Shining Cloud for the Cesarewitch he said that his jockey would be lucky if he picked the right one. Weston is now probably thinking much the same way. Not only did he desert her for Newmarket, but he did not share in her success at Nottingham yesterday. Instead Dines made the acquaintance of his Cesarewitch mount with happy results.

Several good judges of running were doubtful if Doreen Jane did enough to keep her place as favourite in beating Court Equerry by a neck, but the fact remains she keeps on winning. Since Sir Abe Bailey bought her out of a selling race for 360 gns. early in the season, she has not been beaten, and the hat trick completed yesterday includes the Ascot Stakes and the Northumberland Plate.

And whatever spectators thought about Doreen Jane's latest performance, it satisfied both her trainer and her jockey. Dines, indeed, was really delighted. His summing-up was brief and to the point: "I won more easily than would appear to lookers-on, and I am looking forward to the Cesarewitch with considerable confidence."

#### Game Display

Dines did not ride Doreen Jane yesterday as she had been ridden on the two previous occasions. Instead of going off in front, she was kept to the rear until approaching the final bend, and did not go into the lead until little more than a furlong from home. Once in front she struggled on with the utmost gameness, and at least there is no doubt about her stamina.

Polly Stephens did not enhance her Cesarewitch chance by yesterday's display, although it has to be remembered that this was her first race since Ascot. As was the case last year, Polly has been held up by the hard ground, and this Nottingham race has proved a false guide to the Cesarewitch on more than one occasion.

#### Double Hopes?

With Hoplite as well as Doreen Jane in the stable, Cottrill is naturally looking hopefully towards next week, and it would not surprise me if he is also thinking he has a nice chance in the Cambridgeshire with that improving filly Solerina.

The field for the Rufford Abbey Plate cut down so badly that there was nothing to beat yesterday, but at least here is another that keeps on doing it. Solerina has now won four races of the reel and has only been once out of the first three in nine attempts.

Most of the other results brought joy only to the bookmakers. Tinkle Tinkle and La Courcelle were both 100-7 winners, and Penang, who won the Bestwood Nursery for the Aga Khan, was among the 20 to 1 others. Somme Goose, favourite for the latter race, was never in the picture, and those who took part in a mild gamble on Marmion against La Courcelle knew their fate when the horses were a long way from home.

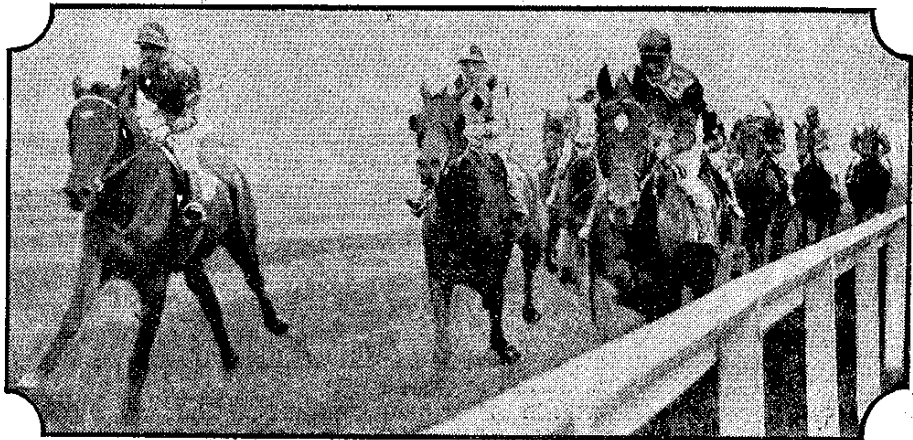
#### Chance for Lost Soul

Cottrill will have several more fancied runners to-day, among them Lost Soul, who has not yet shared the luck of Sir Abe Bailey's other horses. This filly goes for the Trial Plate, and as the distance should suit her better than did the shorter journey at Newmarket last week, her turn may come now. Pepino will go close if Lowrey can nurse him to get the mile, but I like Moldore for a place.

Another with a good chance of atoning for a recent defeat is Diana Buttercup, who beat Cora Deans at Lewes before falling at Manchester. Rosegain, Tetrema and Fugit can all be given reasonable chances on their best form, and on the Leicester running it looks as if Rosegain will be the chief danger to Diana Buttercup.

#### N. CANNON MAY MOVE

It is reported that at the end of the flat-racing season Noel Cannon will probably leave Bedford Lodge at Newmarket to go to the famous Druid's Lodge establishment in Wiltshire to train Mr. J. V. Rank's flat-racers. G. Evans will, it is said, continue to have charge of the jumpers.
