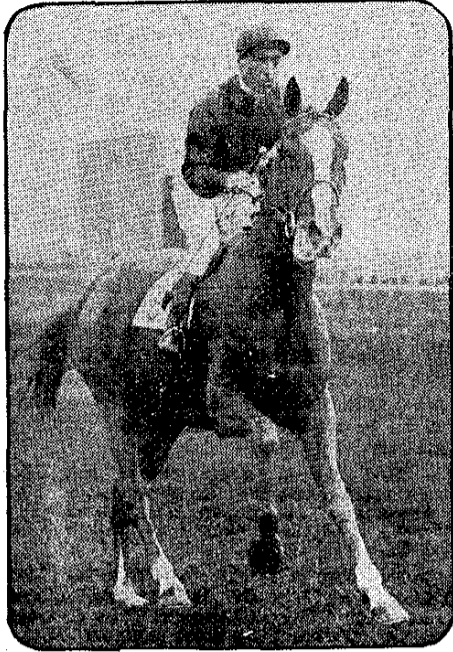

## BARRA SAHIB SCORES AGAIN

### Topweight Victory for Volcanius

## LISTOI HOME

FINAL acceptances for the Cesarewitch are practically only official confirmation of what we had been led to expect. Woodstock is there as the sole hope of the stable that has won the last two Cesarewitches with Seminole and Enfield, and the only chance I see of him losing his position as favourite is a spectacular performance by Tommaok when that Newbury Cup casualty does his final gallop.

At the moment 18 to 1 is the price on offer about Tommaok, but I am quite prepared to see him a sound second favourite, even if he does not pass Woodstock, should his final spin prove satisfactory. Tommaok is still one of the worst horses in the books of those layers who began business early on the race, and his name is linked with nice doubles about very "live" Cambridgeshire horses.

### Barra Sahib Again

Rain and mist spoilt the enjoyment of some good racing at York yesterday; indeed, on such a day a seven-race card seemed all too long. But for once in a way those who subscribed most heartily to that idea were the bookmakers, who, after starting fairly well, "paid out" on three good favourites and two well-backed winners in Listoi and Diosma.

Barra Sahib made a lot more friends by another stylish victory, even although it was only by half a length that he beat the Gimcrack winner, Paul Beg. So far as could be seen, Barra Sahib was in front from start to finish, and it is probable that Smirke could have increased the winning margin had it been necessary.

### First This Time

Another fine victory was that gained by Volcanius in the Chesterfield Handicap. A year ago this Lambton horse could only finish second under 7st. 9lb. Now he carried the weight of 9st. 6lb. and proved much too good for Liberty End, who was receiving 25lb. The latter was not so well fancied as her stable companion, Auld Reekie, who, as at Ayr, let the stable down badly.

Peacock also had two runners in the Rockingham Handicap, and this time he had the winner. Both Moneybox and Listoi were on the 8 to 1 mark, but whereas Moneybox made little show the other was all too good for Litigation and a dozen others. Old Pickle could just be discerned with the leaders at the final turn, and like Disarmament, was much nearer the front than either of the two favourites, Cyrus and Winastep at the finish.

### At York To-day

A big entry for the Little Go Plate to-day contains the names of several prominent Cambridgeshire candidates, but apparently most of them will be conspicuous by their absence when the numbers go up. Finalist, under orders for Haydock Park on Saturday, is a certain non-runner, Badruddin gives way to Maltravers, and Gunboat's not likely to run.

The fact that Mr. Lambton has sent Precious Pearl in preference to several others is a pointer of significance. This colt has done a lot of good work of late, although it may be against him that he has not been out since winning the Victoria Cup in the spring. Harem, who won the corresponding race last year, has done nothing of note of late, and Hidalgo has also been disappointing.

In the circumstances the one I am looking to to-day is Galvani, who beat Almond Hill over this course and distance in August. Of the others there are excellent accounts of Yorkshirer and Eddystone, and as the present going suits the light weights the latter should be good enough to finish in the first three.

## WOODSTOCK IN GOOD GALLOP

### Sirett Rides His Cesarewitch Mount at Newmarket

Woodstock, the Cesarewitch favourite, was ridden by J. Sirett in a good gallop of a mile and three-quarters on the racecourse side at Newmarket yesterday.

The others in the spin were Black Devil (J. Childs), Enfield and Meldrum. Woodstock went very well, and Black Devil also made a good impression.

Captain Whitaker's Cesarewitch horse, Chryslers II, went much better than John James (Jenkins) in a good gallop of two miles. Kniki (S. Middleton) accompanied them for the first mile and a quarter.

## Field for the Cesarewitch

### STILL 29 HORSES IN NEXT BIG RACE

The names of twenty-nine horses appear in the final acceptances for the Cesarewitch, among them the French horse, Nightcap III, whose presence might be the result of an oversight.

The field numbered twenty-seven when Enfield was successful twelve months ago, and except for 1928, when Arctic Star beat fourteen opponents, there have been nearer thirty than twenty runners each year since 1922.
