Lord Moyne, Leader of the House of Lords, made this statement last night during a debate in which peers pressed for more powers for the Minister of Information.

"We want to take off the kid gloves and put on the knucklesusters," was how Lord Daylesunt it, "Propaganda will not be properly organised and directed until one Cabinet Minister only is responsible, and a vigorous offensive made along the whole diplomatic front."

Lord Elibank said that propa gaild should be more journalisti-cally minded than it is, and that a Minister of supreme power

a Minister of Supreme power should be appointed. Lord Strabelgi voiced the U.S. reporters' complaints about not being able to get news here; and Viscount Cevil of Chelwood asked why official communiques should be so baid.

### Efficiency

Lord Moyne said if the Minister of Information, at a moment's notice, went to the micropaone and told everything thousands of lives might be sacrificed. It was better to risk going short of news than to endanger life.

By and large, it must be left to the officers in command of the fighting services to decide what official news could be published.

He agreed that generally official information was smaller than that furnished by the Press, and he added:

"I sometimes wonder whether we are sufficiently grateful for the wonderful efficiency of the British Press services, which carry on in war under difficulties of which perhaps few of us have adequate understanding.




