But miners' delegates com-plained bitterly last month at their conference at Ayr that some coalowners were using the agreement to deprive men of this 6s, bonus unjustly.

MEN ARE EAGER

Mr. Will Lawther, the miners' president, assured me last night that the change in policy will not lead to more absenteelsm or to loss in output. He said :-

"We are prepared to set up local machinery in every coat-field to deal with any person, worker or executive who impedes production by his conduct."

Another leader added: "The miners are as eager as any one to see production improved, and, believe me, the disapprovat of their fellow workers is the greatest deter-

fellow workers is the greatest deter-rent to any one stacking.

"If all parties play fair we can halve the present rate of avoidable absenceism. But our folk will not stand for the present conditions of the bonus, and our decision today will convince the coalowners that it has got to end."

BONUS FORFEIT

The coalowners are now considering the miners' proposal that a day's work lost should mean the forfeit of the bonus for that day only instead of for the whole week they will give their answer in a fortnight. 
