RECORD JUMP BY GERMAN

Hungarian Takes Six Miles Title

BRITISH runners A. W. Sweeney and J. V. Powell showed yesterday that they are likely to retain their titles when the A.A.A. meeting finishes today at the White City, London.

Most of the other titles, however, will change hands owing to the absence of last year's champions or their failure in the qualifying stages.

J. Sheffield (Milanian A.C.) last year's 440 yards hurdles champion, only finished third in his heat yesterday, and failed to qualify for the final.

G. T. Traynor (Thames Valley Harriers), who won the long jump twelve months ago, had bad luck when endeavouring to secure a place in today's final.

His first attempt yesterday was called "no jump," he injured an ankle when taking a second jump and had to retire.

GERMAN RECORD

It is hardly possible, however, that Traynor would have retained the title for the German, who finished second to Leon Sweeney in the Olympic final, set a new world record in the 100 yards dash, and yesterday they triumphed over England by 60 to 85 and Scotland 100 to 90.
