

Tahir lame— Mirza II. may win '2,000'

TAHIR is slightly lame and his expected absence from the "Two Thousand" tomorrow caused business to be slack at the first club call-over yesterday.

It will be a big loss to the stable, for his chance seemed second to none.

Tahir had been in a gallop with Mirza II. and Khan Bahadur at Newmarket on Saturday, but Frank Butters was unable to work his main Derby hope yesterday.

It is expected that stable jockey Smirke will now be on Khan Bahadur, who had not been a certain runner for the "Two Thousand."

Riding plans

THE Aga Khan's policy is for retained jockeys to fix plans well ahead—not to leave the choice of mounts to the last moment.

Smirke has always thought Tahir would outlast Mirza II., for whom Harry Wragg accepted a big retainer for the colt.

Wragg realised that, failing Mirza, there could most probably be a live "second string" on Derby day, whereas the offer made to him for Scottish Union might have left him high and dry had Mr. Rank's colt lacked the necessary stamina or gone wrong before Epsom.

GOLDEN EAGLE, who did a good gallop on Saturday, has been taken out of the "2,000," in which he was to have been ridden by J. Marshall. The colt was cast in his box during the week-end and seriously injured.

Berwick has also been struck out of the "2,000" and, as I mentioned yesterday, hard ground may limit Lawson's day.

Frank Butters saddled four for the Aga Khan in Firdausi's St. Leger and got them into the leading five.

He intends to run five in Friday's One Thousand, but four owners will then be represented.

The Aga Khan runs Ann of Austria (Smirke) and La-Ja-Li (Elliott), the others being Princely (Aga Khan's probable favourite), Sataranna (H. Wragg), Miss Page's Radiant (G. Richards), and Sir Alfred Butt's recent winner, Solan Flower (Perryman).

Distance limitations of the speedies Ann of Austria are realised, but it is thought she might just manage to last the Rowley Mile on the top of the ground.

Derby favourite

THOUGH Portmarnock (7-2) and Pasch (9-2) were preferred at the call-over, I doubt if Mirza II. will remain a 15 to 2 chance tomorrow.

Portmarnock was backed for only £20, whereas he had support for as low as 12 Derby favourite to win 22-50.

Tahir is on offer at 10's for Epsom, Peacock wavering between 10 to 12 and the extended rate of 19 to 3 to take out a similar sum.

Only a trifle went on Pasch for the results.
