

Derby Outsider May Win Stayers Test at Newmarket

THE fate of several prominent Derby horses will be in the balance during the next three days at Newmarket. Perifox is engaged in the Payne Stakes to-day, and as the task will not be so severe as taking on Fair Copy and company in the Newmarket Stakes, he is to take his chance this afternoon in what will prove a real test of stamina.

Perifox is at present second favourite for the Derby. In addition to Sansalvo and Foray there is also Santayana in the stable, and Newmarket is by no means convinced that it has yet found "Boyd Rochfort's best."

The Manton colt, Sauteur, was running on when winning at the last meeting, but from all accounts there is more faith in Joe Lawson's other candidate, Elgar, this time.

Elgar was staying on well when beaten by Renardo and Perifox at the last meeting, so was Inglefield when third to Lady of Milan in Craven week.

The latter was "nibbled at" for the Derby at the last call-over, and it will not surprise me to see him win to-day.

I know he was well tried before his first race, in which he was none too lucky, and Perifox may not give him 17lb over this severe mile and a half.

Smart Newcomer

Karan Sultan has been shaping so well in gallops with Soflo that I am told she is quite likely to make a winning debut in the Haverhill Stakes.

Lady of Milan and Tumbrel are also well fancied; indeed, they think the latter "good" at Beckhampton which she may be after her good show under a big weight behind Zalmis a fortnight ago.

An old friend in President's Putter runs in the Pampisford Stakes, and with the conditions of the race in his favour, Lady Fitzwilliam's youngster looks like winning again. Cliff Richards gets on particularly well with this speedy gelding.

Gallant old Prickett will no doubt fight every inch of the way in the Newmarket Handicap—a £1,000 race that will attract only about half a dozen runners.

The small field will be in his favour, but there may be one too good for him in Edgehill, who is less than half his age.

ENORMOUS crowds went racing yesterday. For Haydock special trains had to be run in duplicate from Liverpool and Manchester. At Ayr the attendance eclipsed that seen at the big September meeting, and the turnstiles at Gatwick had not clicked so merrily for many a long day.

Noble King was a big disappointment to those who made him favourite for the Haydock Coronation Cup, but another topical tip, Atout Royal—which means Royal trump card—stepped into the breach.

Noble King was in front at half way. A furlong from home he was beaten and ultimately finished last.

D. Smith rode the winner to break a spell of more than fifty consecutive losers, and his brother Eph was successful in Gatwick's Coronation race on Punch.

Solar Bear made a big effort to repeat his Queen's Prize win, but that 10 lb. pull made all the difference to Mr. Tommy Westhead's hurdle.

Mr. A. Berry was the winner of Ayr's commemoration trophy, Bold Ben, as I anticipated, staying on better than Bango, who could not get a place this time.

Seneschalstown was rather a surprising favourite considering that he was carrying a 1lb. penalty, but, thanks to the "run" on this one, Bold Ben started at the nice price of 7 to 1.
