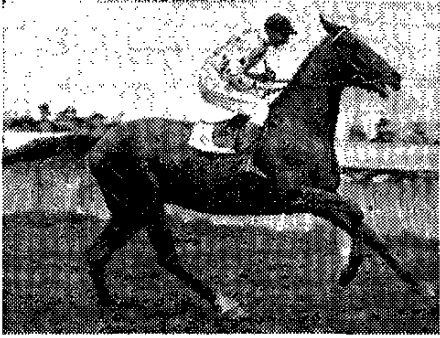


# OMAHA TO MISS GOLD CUP AT ASCOT



Omaha, the American horse who stayed to have another crack at the Gold Cup, and will now be unable to run.

WHAT promises to be a most brilliant Ascot begins to-morrow. There will, however, be one disappointment. Omaha is lame and will not be started for the Gold Cup. Omaha had given great satisfaction in his final gallop for the race on Saturday. But a few hours later a tendon in the near foreleg was found to be slightly filled.

Inflammation followed, and his owner decided to withdraw his champion from Thursday's race. Mr. Woodward's colours will now be carried by Boswell, and the stable will also be represented by Precipitation, who will be ridden by P. Beasley.

Cousine, the only French challenger for the Gold Cup, arrived on Saturday. She is a useful sort of filly, but I cannot gather that there is any of the Brantome confidence behind her.

At Manton they are expecting Cecil to take the trophy. He may well do so if he turns up in one of his happy moods.

### Royal Winners?

Fairlead, Jubilee and Fairey will carry the royal colours this week. Fairey, a winner over the course in Lord Derby's colours last year, is one of the favourites for the Royal Hunt Cup. Fairlead will run for the Ascot Stakes and Jubilee probably for the Chesham Stakes.

The two-year-old must have a big chance as Mumtaz Mahal's flying son, Mirza II, does not run. Fairey's claims are there for all to see yet they may be no stronger than Fairlead's in to-morrow's long distance handicap.

Fairlead was three times a winner last year, and in her last race scored cleverly over two miles at Sandown.

After that she was put to hurdling, but showing no aptitude for this branch of the game returned to Newmarket after one failure in public.

Back to the flat she has been going in her best form lately and obviously pleased W. Jarvis in Saturday's gallop with Firestone. Queen's Shilling and Kidderminster.

Valerian will be Manton's only runner in the race and will probably be favourite to-morrow. None too lucky at Manchester he must have a big chance. So must Kept On who never runs a bad race.

Faites Vos Jeux is another with sound claims, but his chance would not be improved by rain to any extent.



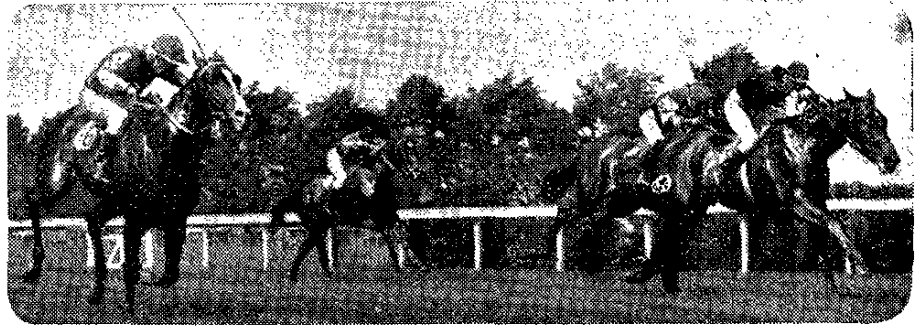

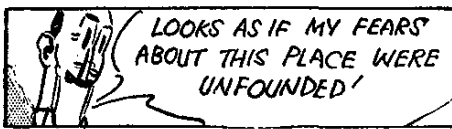
## Short Ration for Northolt Derby
