## FAIRLEAD MAY WIN FOR THE KING

NEWMARKET, Monday.
Forty-four horses left Headquarters for Ascot this morning and with the exception of four they will all be seen out at the opening stage.
The best has not yet been seen of Quorn II, who is a fine stayer, but he is well up in the handicap in the Ascot Stakes.
Guiscard appears to be as well as ever despite his nine years. Theddingworth went well on Saturday, as did the King's filly, Fairlead, who will be having her first race of the season.
Farsi, Troun de l'Air and Chantarella are more or less fancied, but my vote goes to Fairlead.

#### FROM OTHER QUARTERS

Lambouen. — Winnebar (1.30, each way), Carioca (2.30 and 3.30, each way), Faltes vos Jeux (2.30); Tamasha (4.0), Tract (4.30, each way) and Fairford (5.0) are our fancted runners at Ascot Epsom.—Mrs. Grundy (2.30) is thought to be good. Jupiter (3.30) and Hazel (4.0) should both finish in the first three.

Manton.—Cold Scent (1.30), Valerian (2.30), Foxfield (3.30, each way) and Cash Book (5.0) will all go close.

Beckhampton.—Madrina (4.0) may be placed. Le Bambino (4.30) should not be far away.

Middleham.—Silversol runs for the Gold Vase and is fully expected to win. Dartside (4.0) and Kelpie (4.0) have each-way chances.

Malton.—Union Jack (4.0) is fancied each way.

### Pat Donoghue's Pony **Derby Hat Trick**

Mrs. Chester Beatty's Short Ration won the Northolt Derby yesterday to complete a hat trick for Pat Donoghue, who has trained the winner of the Northolt Derby for three successive years.

Short Ration is a son of Manna, on which Pat's father, Steve Donoghue, won the Epsom Derby in 1925. The winner was a hot favourite at 11 to 8 on.

Pat Donoghue's previous successes in the race were gained with Evasion and Ethelstone, and all three were ridden by T. Carey. Results:—

Manton's chief hopes to-day, however, centre in Valerian a 1 Cash Book. The former goes for the Ascot Stakes, and, in view of his nar row defeat in the Manchester Cup, he must possess a splendid chance. The King's filly, Fairlead, Faites Vos Jeux, Corofin, Farsi and the consistent Kept On are all soundly fancied, and perhaps Fairlead will prove Valerian's most dangerous rival.

Goya II, Le Grand Duc, Full Sail and Fairford will be among Cash Book's opponents in the St. James's Palace Stakes, which will show right—or wrong—was the Derby form. At this distance it would have been a near thing between Goya II and Fairford at Epsom, but I like Goya II best now because the uphill finish may tell in his favour.

# RECORD IN DANGER

FOURTEEN years ago a flying grey filly made history at Ascot by winning her race by ten lengths. Her name was Mumtaz Mahal—to become affectionately abbreviated to just "Mumty"

To-day her son, Mirza II—bay in colourruns for the Coventry Stakes, and at Newmarket they are speculating on the possibility of mother's record being put in the shade. "Mumty" won by a mere three lengths when she made her first appearance at Newmarket. When Mirza II made his debut last month he strolled home by six lengths. Three lengths further away Open Door was third, and he was good enough to win the Great Surrey Foal Stakes on his next appearance.

Dark Tolly, twice a winner and unbeaten, is the best of Mirza's known rivals to-day. Onslaught, owned by Lord Derby, is probably the best of the newcomers. Mirza II will be confidently backed to beat both and the rest of them.

#### 'Ware "Good Things ''

A horse that has never won a race will be favourite for the opening event, and later on there will be another with a similar record in the Vase.

Sandsprite, the 100 to 1 Derby second, is the first. With his pull in the weights he should surely win the Prince of Wales's Stakes; but you know the fate that so often awaits these Ascot "good things," so don't gamble.

Second last season, Fearless Fox makes another attempt on the Vase. He was also runner-up in the St. Leger, and again at Chester this year, so at least he deserves a first.




