

# More 'Flying' Expected from Mirza II To-day

At odd times you will hear moans that "England doesn't breed stayers" these days. But we can breed "flyers," and after all, they are the sort that provide the real thrills.

The Tetrarch, Mumtaz Mahal, Colombo and Orwell drew the crowds wherever they went and whatever they used to meet.

The present-day counterpart to these speed-merchants is Mirza II, who makes his third appearance when he turns out for the July Stakes at Newmarket to-day.

With two effortless victories to his credit, he will be an odds-on chance, and I shall be surprised and disappointed if he does not give Smirke another of those armchair rides.

Ramtapa, also an Ascot winner, did not leave with the other Manton horses yesterday. He may go by road this morning. I hope he does, since Sir Abe Bailey's colt is probably the second-best two-year-old we have seen this season.

With the conditions of the Bottisham Stakes so much in his favour, Finalist looks like being another warm favourite. He should win, and so I hope will Respondentia, from all accounts one of the most fancied runners from Beckhampton during the week.

Fairlead, a big disappointment in the Ascot

Stakes, should carry the royal colours prominently in the Hare Park Handicap; indeed, running next door to her stable, she may easily win.

One they all have to beat, however, is Esquemeling. This colt was close up fourth in the Newbury Cup, and Mr. James de Rothschild has frequently found the July Course a lucky track.

"Following Gordon" at Wolverhampton yesterday proved quite satisfactory, even if the odds-on Titlark did get "lost" by the outsider Hurry de Savoie.

Richard's first winner was Bonnie Scotland, who deserved his victory in the Dunstall Plate after two seconds and a third.

Number two was Rawana, who came up at 5 to 1 to the complete satisfaction of those who had coupled him with the two-year-old in the tote double.

Ramayana II, heavily backed to beat Bonnie Scotland, was a big disappointment. Tumult colt, on the other hand, was never far away, and his turn ought to come shortly.
