MUCH to please, yet more than one tinge of disappointment at Newmarket yesterday. Everybody was delighted with the much-improved paddock on the July Course. Instead of the second and third horses being unsaddled among the crowd there are now separate enclosures for the first three. A new stand has been built for trainers and jockeys, and a much-improved number-board has been erected.

Mirza II, the flyer, played the part assigned him. The disappointment was that Ramtapa stayed at home, which left the prize a gift to the Aga Khan's brilliant colt.

Goodness knows how far he could have won if Smirke had really let him out. As it was he beat Jubilee Day by six lengths, and he was merely cantering for the greater part of the journey.

In the ring they laid odds of 100 to 6 on Mirza II. Those who backed him, hopefully, on the tote had their stakes returned. The newcomer Heru was the popular choice for second place in the forecast pool. He finished last of the quartet.

Second disappointment was the narrow defeat of the King's filly Fairlead, whom the Princess Royal came to see run after riding on the Heath during the morning.

Fairlead did not get the luck of the race. She had to come between a group of horses to make her challenge, whereas Incendiaire got a clear run on the outside, and just held on to win by a head.

Incendiaire was bought to assist Fairford in his preparation for the Derby, and his success adds another to Sir Abe Bailey's non-stop run.

Finalist Scores

Finalist took full advantage of favourable conditions to score his first victory of the season in the Bottisham Plate rather than wait for the stiffer task presented by to-day's Duke of Cambridge Handicap.

Harry Wragg will now be free to ride Commander III again, and although it must be a close call with Monument on the Jubilee form, if Boyd-Rochford's horse is saddled, I hope to see the Kempton winner score again.

His Grace, Rippon Tor, Remember II and Pike Barn will give the affair quite a big race flavour, and Pike Barn will no doubt give them all plenty to do.
