## FLYING MIRZA II SHOULD WIN AGAIN

**MIRZA II** will again be a big attraction at Newmarket to-day, even though the Aga Khan's flyer looks like frightening away most of the opposition in the Chesterfield Stakes.

Nothing that has been out should have a chance against **Mirza II**, but I am warned that he may not have things all his own way against the **Eppie Adair** filly.

This young lady is a half-sister to Robin Goodfellow, and although I cannot see her beating **Mirza II** "first time out," she is, from all accounts, one that will make a name for herself in due course.

A number of horses which will be talked about later on for the Cesarewitch run for the Summer Handicap, but **Miss Windsor**, **Jack Tar**, **Velvet Cushion** and **Epigram** will not be among them.

**Newtown Ford** has come from Yorkshire with a hopeful chance, but it will not surprise me to see **Patriot King** make the most of his light weight on a course that has frequently been lucky for **Mr. James de Rothschild**. **Rodomont**, with **Richards** up, should be placed.

**Richards** may be on a good thing in **Prada**, who has waited for the **Reach Plate**, and in the **Bury Handicap** he should not be far away on **Blue Car** in face of strong opposition from **Cosmo Lass** and **Pendulum**. **BOUVERIE**

## FROM THE STABLES

"AFTER that, **Constellate** must be one of the favourites for the Stewards' Cup," we were all saying when the **Lambourn** filly went under by a neck to **Malmsey** in the July Handicap yesterday.

An hour or so later we were to learn that **Constellate** had already been taken out of the race, and with her had gone **Slap** and **Tickle**, who only missed third place by a nose.

**Malmsey** can still be there in a fortnight's time for his owner-trainer, **R. O. Dawson**. But I am afraid that 10lb. penalty will put him out of it. I know it didn't stop **Solerina** last year, but that filly won first in altogether different style on the July course.

### Constellate Checked

**Malmsey** was, perhaps, not such a sprightly starter as several others, but the luck that was going towards the judge's end was certainly on his side.

**Malmsey** had shaken off **Sidley Dee** coming out of the dip and left with a clear course, whereas, **Constellate** appeared to be momentarily checked when **Sidley Dee** "hung" slightly.

**Harry Wragg**, however, soon had her chasing the leader with great gusto, which she failed to catch only by a neck, with **Sidley Dee** only a head away.

Those "good things" in the other races were not nearly so obliging as they had been on the previous day.

After **Beckhampton's** double with **Sweet Alyssum** and **Tumbrel**, **Judy O'Grady** found two too good for her in the seller, and **Dark Tolly** only shared the Sale Stakes because **Berestella** left the straight line when leading.

**Lord Lonsdale** was present to see **Tumbrel** win, and he must have been delighted with her stout-hearted display. She wore down the heavy-backed **Penkuik** fairly and squarely, and then held off **Black Lashes** with the greatest determination.

**Sweet Alyssum** carried the colours of **Captain R. Macdonald-Buchanan**, a son-in-law of the late **Lord Woolavington**. They are only a slight variation of those carried by **Captain Cuttle**, **Coronach** and company, but a turquoise for a red cap gives them an altogether different appearance.

Easily the best race of the day was the **Zetland Stakes**, in which at least eight horses were in a line with less than a furlong to go.

**Sea Tonic**, **Startled**, **Silver Lance**, **Foxchase** and **Parkin** were among them, and it was only in the last stride that **Parkin** did the trick.
