Richards—5 Off the Reel

Gordon Richards accomplished one of those remarkable feats he seems to be able to manage at least once a year when he rode five winners in succession at Worcester on Saturday.

Devon, second in the sequence, was his 100th winner of the season, and the crowd showed their appreciation of the fact by giving him an especial cheer.

After that each success was greeted with eloquent testimony to the popularity of a remarkable young man.

Curiously enough, Richards's only loser came from the stable which has first claim on his services. This was Huxley, who could only get third to Spartan III and Highlander in the last race.

The break prevented any possibility of Richards eclipsing his performance at Chesham in 1933, when he went through the card on the first day and rode the first five winners on the second.

To-day he rides Pervoni (2.0), Rawana (3.0), Pompeia c (3.30) and Respondentia (4.30).

Richards has been champion jockey ten times in the last twelve seasons, and during his career has ridden 2,114 winners in 11,232 mounts.

£45,000 HORSE TO BE RETIRED

TIMES do change! A few years ago we should have been wondering whether Goodwood had been abandoned if the Stewards' Cup had led to such little betting as it has done this year.

Goodwood begins to-morrow, so unless they really get busy at to-day's call-over we may not even know the favourite until the horses go to the post.

As usual there are any amount of tips for the race. At Newmarket they are torn between King's Gap, Grandjo and Veuve Cliquot—not badly handicapped in spite of her big weight.

At Lambourn Ipsden is the popular choice. Though they do not put a victory for the lightly-weighted Permenance beyond the realm of probability.

Gunboat—with lucky Paddy Maher in the saddle—is another expected to play a bold part, and so, of course, is The Drummer, who will be the first Northerner to win for many a year if he takes the Cup back to Lancashire.

The Drummer will be ridden by that much-improved youngster, H. Blackshaw, and it will be a feather in his cap if he disproves the idea that the Stewards' Cup is not a race for lightweights.

With Mirza II as "captain," Frank Butters will take a formidable two-year-old team to the meeting—among them Khan Bahadur, a chestnut brother to the grey Derby winner, Mahmood, who makes his debut in the Richmond Stakes.

Ann of Austria, Bahuddin, Dharampur, Far West, La-Li, Mange Tout and Tahir are also among the probables, so it will be surprising if we do not see quite a lot of the green and chocolate hoops during the four days.

Pherozshah is not to be saddled for the Stewards' Cup, and Miss Paget's Golden Hair colt will miss the meeting. Radiant will run for Miss Paget in the Ham Stakes or Richmond Stakes to-morrow, or in the Molecomb Stakes on Friday.
