

RICHARDS STEERS £90 HORSE TO VICTORY IN STEWARDS' CUP

THOSE who believe that a jockey in luck is the man to follow found the winner of the Stewards' Cup. Taking his Worcester luck to Goodwood, Gordon Richards drew a high number for Firozepore, took the rails as soon as he could, went into the lead at about half-way, and stayed there.

The very lucky owner of the winner is Mr. R. B. Strassburger, an American who has been racing in France for many years. Firozepore was bred by the Aga Khan in France, and his present owner secured him for the equivalent of about £90—a nice bargain.

No doubt there will be arguments as to whether with equal luck in the draw Harmachis would have been first instead of second. Drawn No. 3 this northerner did not enjoy the clear run they had on the far side, but he was going great guns at the finish, and went under only by a neck.

Gunboat and Wyndham also appeared to finish very fast, but they may have been flattered in this respect because so many of those immediately in the rear were stopping.

King's Gap and George Here, both badly drawn, were the early leaders, and going down the hill the latter put in such a burst that he must have been lengths clear.

Carissa, towards the far side, was also holding her own with Firozepore. So were Kong and Red Garter. Then towards halfway the "stopping" began.

King's Gap George Here and Red Garter all dropped back, and Carissa again made it plain that five furlongs is the length of her tether.

At the finish nothing was going better than Wyndham. It would not have surprised one to have found that he was third. Ipsden proved best of the others, without ever appearing likely to win. Permanence ran well enough to merit a note as a "winner soon."

Tahir, Solfo, and Unbreakable played their parts valiantly in the other races, in particular the last named, who wore blinkers and ran his race out as straight as a gunbarrel.

Mahmoud's brother, Khan Bahadur, is bigger than was the grey Derby winner at his age. He ran a nice race for a newcomer, and should join the Aga Khan's list of two-year-old winners long before the season is out.

NEGRIER EACH WAY FOR BIG RACE

GOODWOOD gives us the long and the short of racing to-day. The Stakes is the longest distance handicap decided during the season. The Lavant Stakes will be one of the shortest if Mirza II leaves his rivals from the gate as he usually does.

Chatsworth, Silver Spear II, and the Manton newcomer Aoudaia, will line up with the Aga Khan's flyer. Unless we are in for a huge surprise the question is not whether he will win, but by how far will he do so.

P. Maher won the Goodwood Stakes last year on the eight-year-old chaser named Avondale. To-day he rides a horse half his size—to wit Epigram—and it will not surprise me in the least if he makes it a double.

Rondo, the penalised African Lily, Sir Callidore, from Lancashire, Miss Windsor, Signature, and Negrier are other fancied runners in an open race.

In the ordinary way I am not in love with each way betting, but this particular race appears to warrant it with Negrier as the one to be "on."

This six-year-old was none too lucky when second in the Rosebery Memorial Handicap. Last time out he only just missed a place behind Newtown Ford at Newmarket. He now has a pull of 8lb. with African Lily who was second on that occasion.

Nectar II has made the long journey from Middleham for the Trundle Stakes, and I hope to see him continue his successful sequence. Dangers are Columelle and Castel St. Angelo.

STABLE NEWS: Newmarket's Bid for To-day's Stakes

NEWMARKET, Tuesday.

Among the twenty-three horses that left headquarters this morning to meet their engagements at the second stage of Goodwood were some of the best animals in training.

The unbeaten Mirza II could not have done better since his runaway victory at the Second July meeting, and he should pick up another prize in the Lavant Stakes.

The Goodwood Stakes will see a field of good stayers go to the post, and this looks like proving the best race of the day.

African Lily is again expected to finish in front of Rodomont.

Signature is one that cannot be left out. He has been gradually improving all the year.

The distance will not beat Satanis, but he will be hardly good enough for this race, and African Lily should prove our best.
