

# PADDY MAHER'S DOUBLE IN THE GOODWOOD STAKES

## MIRZA II AGAIN

FOR once in a way Mirza II did not get all the glory at Goodwood yesterday. The Aga Khan's flyer won right enough, but credit for the best performance belongs to Epigram — and Paddy Maher. Brilliant riding by this jockey won the Goodwood Stakes for Mr. J. V. Rank's four-year-old, who would have been the unluckiest horse breathing to have missed the prize.

After rounding the final bend in pursuit of Thoth and Negrier Epigram got a bad bump that knocked him out of his stride, and put him in grave danger of being shut right out. Signature took advantage of his misfortune to jump into the lead, and unimpeded on the outside Sir Calidore and Fox Star also came on the scene.

The outlook for Epigram certainly looked black, but his quick thinking jockey was equal to the emergency.

No more than fifty yards from the post he saw an opening, Epigram found the speed, and a great burst enabled Maher to supplement his victory on Avondale in the same race last year.

Negrier, never out of the first four and for the most part third, just failed to save the place money, but his turn should come on softer going.

No "fireworks" this time from Mirza II. Not that he was ever in danger of defeat, but that spectacular dash from the gate was missing, and Smirke was never far enough in front to take it easy.

Still, as Silver Spear II had been little more than three lengths behind Mirza II on level terms at Ascot, I suppose we should hardly rub our eyes at only a length between them with the former now getting 14lb.

### Stable's Seconds

After Silver Spear II and Signature, Captain Boyd-Rochfort had another second when Foray ran up against Veuve Clicquot at her best in the King George Stakes.

For five and a half furlongs Foray looked to be getting the better of it, but the filly put in a brilliant spurt close home and in winning by half a length beat the record for the six furlong course by 1-5s.

Jack Jarvis and E. Smith had another winner and the bookmakers their first respite when Quorn II won the Trundle Stakes. Columille ran a fine race under his big weight, and would not have missed a place if he had secured a clear course.

## Cecil May Do It Again

First three in the Goodwood Cup last year, Cecil, Enfield and Quashed, meet again in today's race over the "marathon" distance of two miles and five furlongs.

Cecil, a decisive winner twelve months ago, carries the steadier of 9st. 11lb. Enfield's weight is the same as it was on that occasion, which means a 5lb. pull. For a two lengths beating Quashed has to give Enfield 2lb. instead of receiving two, so it looks as if both colts should beat her again.

Between them it should be a much nearer thing than it was last year, but I think Cecil will win again, because he can usually find that bit of finishing speed lacking in so many at the end of a long journey.

Shalfleet also takes on a big weight-carrying task in the Singleton Handicap, in which he has to concede as much as 40lb. to Kingsbury.

Even with this big burden I am quite prepared to see him in the thick of the fight, but as Crampit has recovered from the kick she received at Brighton the filly may come out on top with her pull of 26lb.

Best thing of the day should be Caerloptic, who has waited for the Foxhall Stakes. Another two-year-old winner may be Onslaught, who followed Mirza II home at Ascot.

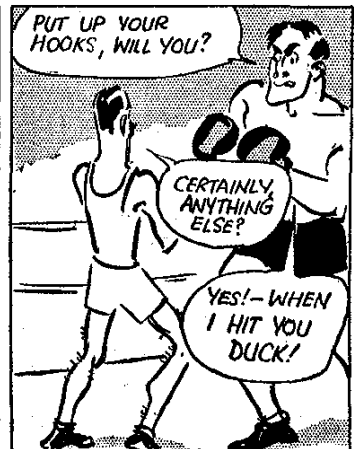

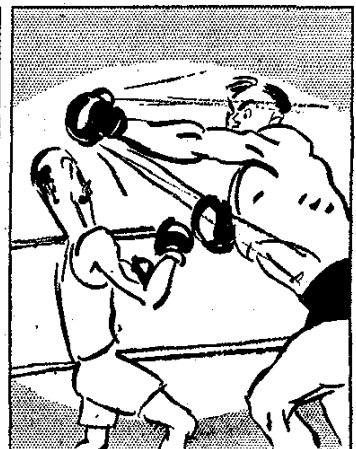
