**Cecil May Do** It Again

First three in the Goodwood Cup last year, Gecil, Enfield and Quashed, meet again in to-day's race over the "marathon" distance of two miles and five furlongs. Cecil, a decisive winner twelve months ago, carries the steadier of 9st. 111b. Enfield's weight is the same as it was on that occasion, which means a 5lb, pull. For a two lengths beating Quashed has to give Enfield 2lb. in-stead of receiving two, so it looks as if both colts should beat her again. Between them it should be a much nearer thing than it was last year, but I think Cecil will win again, because he can usually find that bit of finishing speed lacking in so many at the end of a long journey. Shalfeet also takes on a big weight-carrying task in the Singleton Handicap, in which he has to concede as much as 400b. to Kingsbury. Even with this big burden I am quite pre-pared to see him in the thick of the fight, but as Grampit has recovered from the kick she received at Brighton the filly may come out on top with her pull of 26lb. Best thing of the day should be Caerloptic, who followed Mirza II home at Ascot. BOUVERIE





