

PERIFOX STABLE MAY SCORE TREBLE AT MANCHESTER

TRAINERS were saying nice things about Manchester yesterday. For the first time for several weeks their eyes were gladdened by the sight of almost perfect going. Not so complimentary were those who had hoped to find winners. Changed conditions invariably add to the difficulties of a never-easy task and more than one result gave warning of danger ahead.

Biggest surprise of the day was the success of Delphi in the Autumn Foal Plate. Carrying Sir Alfred Butt's colours, this youngster represented Frank Butters in preference to Radiant, apparently with more hope than confidence, judging by the betting.

Delphi got home by a head, and that he did so was entirely due to a bit of quick thinking on the part of D. Smith.

Golden Eagle and Straight Eye had both loomed large in the picture before Trigonon and Ganymede drew away. But there was just enough room for Smith to come between them, which he did to get up on the post.

Smith has an excellent chance of completing a nice double to-day on Enstone, who represents the Perifox stable in the Prince Edward Handicap.

Boyd-Rochfort's horse is a big chap that should find the softened ground just to his liking, and on his Hurst Park form should at least again beat Greynam.

Cesarewitch Horses

Nine or ten Cesarewitch horses will be in the field, of which Nectar II is better treated now than any of the others in the Newmarket race.

"Fancied each way" says the Middleham report concerning the Northumberland Plate winner. Similar hopes are entertained about Barthstopper from Manton and Miss Windsor from Lambourn.

Miss Windsor is the one I fear most of this trio, and if she gets no more than a place on this occasion I think her turn will come. In addition to Enstone, the Perifox stable will be represented by Entertainer II in the Yarn Plate, in which a repetition of her Sandown form should make her a ready winner. Boyd-Rochfort's third runner is Tolman, who holds a bright chance in the St. Devis Plate.

Cottrill has sent Midkato in preference to his other entries for the Wilton Nursery, and it may be as well to take the tip. Although there were only twenty-eight runners for the six races, Folkestone could not improve on Manchester's one winning favourite. And as this was the 7 to 2 on Frolic Wind, no need to ask whether the bookmakers went home happy.

Besides winning on Frolic Wind, Richards upset Toward Point with Port of Call, but was unplaced on the "warm" Royal Laird and last of three on the odds-on Bellrue.

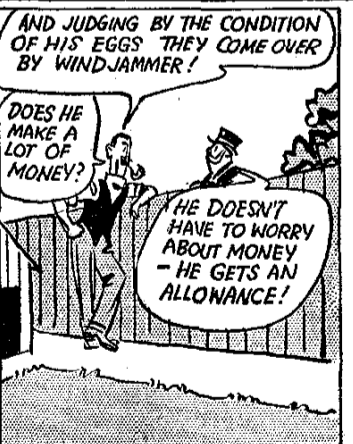
