 MIRZA II is still a flyer for five furlongs and no further. At that distance he would have been an easy winner of the Middle Park Stakes yesterday. That extra furlong stopped him, and a never-say-die effort by Richards on Mr. J. V. Rank's Scottish Union did the rest.
 Very much on his toes as he went out, Mirza II showed all his early brilliance from the gate. It was to be no waiting this time, and before they had gone half a furlong he was lengths clear.
 Down the hill with the dust flying from under his feet, he held at least a three-lengths advantage with Smirke still sitting still and P. Beasley pushing Unbreakable in an effort to reduce the gap.
 Unbreakable did not last much longer as a race danger, but as soon as Mirza II struck the rising ground one could sense that Smirke was apprehensive.
 At the same moment Richards realised what might happen. Still a good two lengths behind, he kept Scottish Union hard at it, and a tired Mirza was caught almost in the last stride.
 The race proved conclusively that Mirza II does not stay, just as the Lowther Stakes suggested Maranta will not find the finishing speed to win the Cesarewitch even if he gets the trip.
 Flares gave Sir Abe Bailey's colt 30lb. and an easy beating, which means that if Maranta has a chance for the Cesarewitch, Flares would have a better one with 9st. 8lb.
 Ipsden settled all doubt about the sprint championship when he beat Foray in effortless style in the Challenge Stakes. And he gave his three rivals a bit of start from the gate at that.

To-day's Card

Last stage of the meeting hardly looks up to Newmarket standard. Indeed, only two of the six races call for any comment.
 First is the Exning Welter, and with Constellate, Carnival Boy and Broken Seal among the probables, this should be the best race of the day.
 Carnival Boy is such a consistent colt that he can never safely be left out, but he may now be a bit too near Constellate, whose turn may come at last.
 Mahmoud's brother, Khan Bahadur, will not be saddled for the Prendergast Stakes, the Aga Khan instead being represented by Far West.
 On softer going my choice would have been Buckwood. As it is, Bonnie Scotland gets the vote because he is not averse to firm going.
CESAREWITCH PLANS
 Captain Elsey will accept with Beleaguered in the Cesarewitch. He has also Union Jack, April the Third and Bughrig in the race.
 Vatelior, the French horse, has been withdrawn from the Cesarewitch, and this leaves another French candidate, Cousine, at the head of the handicap with 8st. 13lb.
 Predicateur, also a "Frenchman," is another that has been taken out.
