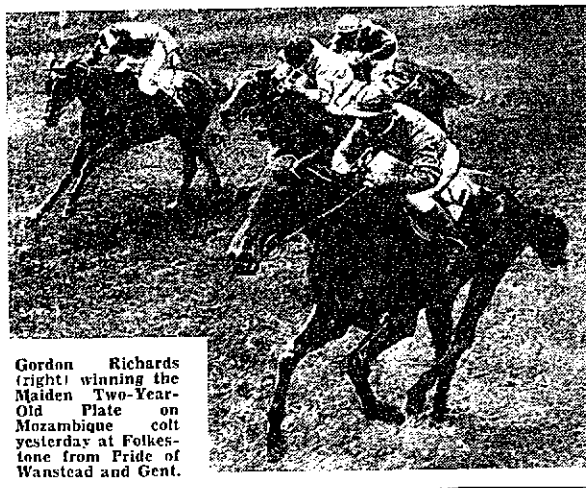


ANOTHER WINNER FOR GORDON
