

FOUR HOT FAVOURITES FAIL SMALL FIELDS-AND A WALK-OVER

PHONETIC SCORES AT A GENEROUS PRICE By THE SCOUT

NOTTINGHAM, Monday. WHAT with a walk-over for the chief race, four odds-on favourites falling on the reel, you can imagine that our sport was distinctly mixed at Nottingham today. Naturally Fire Music, as a winner without a penalty, was made an odds-on favourite as a getting-out medium.

It was a striking sign of the present hard ground that Light o' Love was allowed a bloodless victory in the Harrington Stakes, a handicap worth £242.

There was, I believe, a thought of starting the good top-weight, Alaska, a French-bred four-year-old, who was to concede 10lbs. Sir Abe Bailey's colt has not run in this country, but he would have been fancied, so no doubt he is being kept for something more important.

Anyway, keep Alaska in mind. O.T.C. also missed a good chance on his favourite course. Mr. Glasspool would naturally have preferred a race, and a bet on his well-treated Light o' Love, but he will agree that he never made a more wise purchase. Colledge Leader has a half here. A walk-over is also a bet in the rear. Ferryman was in the saddle.

WHEN four odds-on chances were picked many must have wondered what might have been Light o' Love's fate. I must however state that I was actually surprised to find Phonetic a five to one chance for the Savile Plate, as so many had remarked at Epsom that

Phonetic was a sure win in a nice two-year-old race.

And yet Phoneticilly, as well as the odds-on Orana were preferred to him. Orana is speedy, but Phonetic was going so smoothly that Weston had to set him some way from home, and Phonetic won with more in hand than a half-length would suggest.

You know Cecil Gray's style. It completed a double for him.

Surprising Betting THE betting was also more surprising than the result in the opening series. For Social Event, a nine to four chance, was always going to be well for Ferryman in the Savile Handicap—which I had good to see such a popular trainer as Mr. Ferguson change his luck with ease, for Ferryman had a race in which he came back from Epsom. They laid two to one on Spinlock, and he looked to be going to win, but was outwitted on the winning leader, but Elgg showed good stamina and stayed there by three lengths.
