DERBY FORM CONFIRMED AT NEWMARKET

Smashing Victory in Burwell Stakes TO-DAY'S TEST

ANTICIPATION and realisation in racing are often very different quantities. They were at Newmarket yesterday when I looked for a battle between Hyperion, Young Lover, Tai-Yang and company, but it dwindled down to a three-cornered fight between the Derby winner, King Salmon and the very disappointing Harinero.

Still, it is always good to see a great horse in action, and Weston showed us Hyperion at his best. On top of Busnes Hill Harinero led him by a length. Going into the dip Weston decided that it was time to get a move on, and in a few strides he had swept into the lead, and, although Wragg was after him on King Salmon, the margin was only three-quarters of a length by kind permission Truly Hyperion is a great little horse.

Smart Juvenile

Newcomers are always among the most interesting of the runners at Newmarket. We were introduced to one with a big home reputation in Apollo in the Pampisford Stakes, and, judging by the good fight he made of it with the experienced Mythical Monk, he will improve on acquaintance. Sir Alfred Butt's horse had to be put under the whip to get the better of him, and I should be disappointed if the grey does not make a bit of a name for himself.

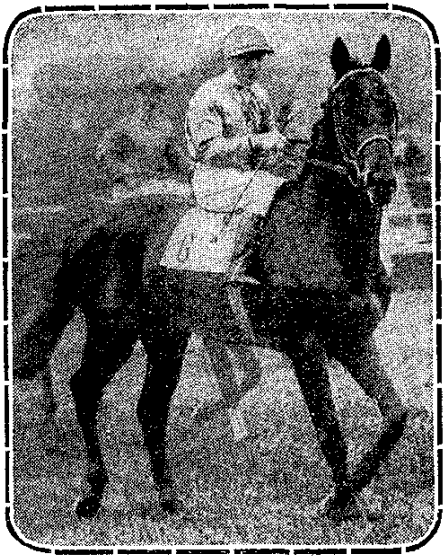
Another good thing justified a short price when Instantaneous gained her first victory in the Haverhill Stakes. Here again, however, there were some anxious moments as Foxcroft drew alongside the Manton filly, and for fully a furlong they raced head to head. All ended well when Instantaneous found a bit more up the hill, but it was a near thing. Mistress of Arts shaped like winning; over a shorter course.

Canon Law Absent

Like Young Lover, Canon Law stayed away from the Newmarket Handicap owing to the firm ground, and with the conditions exactly as she likes them Effaceable strolled home an easy winner from Shrewton and the hard-riden Rock Star. Free Fare ran a lifeless sort of race, suggesting that he wants his summer's rest. Abbots Worthy was never dangerous, and Highlander was done with as soon as an extra effort was required.

Orders Gray did not run up to the form he had shown at the last meeting in the Somerville Stakes, but Dispensation and Smoke Screen reproduced their previous running almost to the ounce. Dispensation won after an interesting tussle with The Jesuit to complete a double for Sir Alfred Butt, and she ran on with a determination one likes to see in a two-year-old. Both Saxham Cat colt and Berebos, who deputised for Avertin, set themselves too much to do from the start.

T. Hawcroft and J. Lewis, who were first and second in the last race at Alexandra Park on Monday, were now concerned in the finish of the Apprentice Handicap, but this time Lewis came out on top. He was on Junior Counsel, and it was only by a head that he defeated Hawcroft on Millrock. The once smart mare, Hot Bun, was running on very strongly at the finish.

BOUVERIE'S CENTURY

Hyperion yesterday was Bouverie's hundredth winner of the season. He also gave EFFACEABLE (5 to 2) MYTHICAL MONK (11 to 10) INSTANTANEOUS (8 to 13)

Mythical Monk and Effaceable landed the tote double, and Dispensation (11 to 4), another winner, was Bouverie's place horse on the tote.

The fact that Valerius made a bit of a stir in the last Derby call-over will add interest to his bout with Windsor Lad in the Newmarket Stakes to-day. And the fact that Nicoll and Smirke, their respective jockeys, are to meet in a boxing bout at Birmingham in June will add a certain piquancy to the affair. The bout that follows in the ring is in no sense a "personal affair" connected with racing. Both jockeys are useful with the gloves, and a charity show has been chosen at which to prove who is the better.

Windsor Lad's Progress

Valerius and Windsor Lad were on the same mark in the Free Handicap, but they would not be if the weights were revised. Sir Abe Bailey's colt has had two races without showing any improvement on his juvenile form, whereas Windsor Lad's Chester victory on his

First appearance does report progress. Flamenco, as I have said, will assist in giving a line with the Guineas form, but like Valerius, he should not beat Windsor Lad on what has been seen this year.

Wantalot won the Meldreth Welter last year after a failure at the Guineas meeting. A fortnight ago he was third to Galvani, and history may be repeated further by a victory to-day. Bishop's move is expected to add to his recent victory with another in the Shelford Plate, and, although there is a big tip for Blue Domino, I prefer the Epsom horse because he is sure to stay the distance.

CARRIFF'S NEXT RACE

Sir Thomas Dixon's Cariff, winner of the Irish Two Thousand Guineas at the Curragh last week, will not be started for the Baldoye Derby on Whit Monday. His trainer, Philip Behan, has decided not to run the colt again before the Irish Derby in June, and he will subject Cariff to a special preparation for that event.

STABLE NEWS

Barred UMBER Expected To Be Newmarket's Best

NEWMARKET, Tuesday.

At the second stage to-morrow the programme is a good one, and we have between fifty and sixty likely runners.

The Newmarket Stakes is the chief event, Flamenco, who ran quite a good race for the Two Thousand Guineas, looks to have the beating of Valerius.

Of Frank Butters's pair I like Barred UMBER, who will run well, and Black Devil may prove the best from Clarchaven Lodge. However, I shall take Barred UMBER to win.

Maltravers, a stable companion of Barred UMBER, should be noted for the Spring Two-Year-Old Stakes. He should be all the better for the "eye-opener" he had at the First Spring Meeting.

Broadcaster has not much to do in the Duxford Selling Plate. If he reproduces his Doncaster form he will be hard to beat.

There looks like being a fairly strong field for the Shelford Plate. Jiffy has been third in her three races this season, and will not be easily beaten.

Shalfleet failed when made favourite for the Free Handicap. He has made good progress since, and may do better in the Chesterford Plate. HEATHMAN.

FAMOUS TRAINER MOVES

Mr. Fred Butters, the Newmarket trainer, is leaving the Heath House stables at the end of next week and is moving to Kingsclere, where he will train for Captain Arnold Wills and others.

Butters will take with him some of the horses at present in his charge and will be prepared to train also for other racehorse owners.

Kingsclere is one of the most famous training establishments in the country. It was on these downs that the late John Porter trained his seven Derby winners, Blue Gown, Shotover, St. Blaise, Ormonde, Saintoin, Common and Flying Fox, and the late King Edward VII's horses were trained there before being moved to Newmarket to be taken over by the late Richard Marsh.
