VALERIUS WELL BEATEN BY

FLAMENCO

Successful Raid by Lambourn Stables TO-DAY'S HINTS

THOSE who have got long prices about Windsor Lad for the Derby will be delighted with themelves after the result of the Newmarket Stakes. The records will show that Windsor Lad beat Flamenco by a length, but only those who saw the race can appreciate the full value of the victory.

Windsor Lad had two different and distinct races during the mile and a quarter gallop on a course that finds out weak spots in all but the stoutest. In the first he had to shak off a very determined Valerius, and when he had accomplished the task down swooped Harry Wragg on Flamenco, who had been kept in the rear for a burst of speed at the finish.

Winner's Stamina

It was a cleverly thought out piece of work and brilliantly executed. Halfway down the hill Flamenco had drawn level with Windsor Lad, and onlookers were quite prepared for yet another Derby hope to be shattered. Then, however, out came the fighting qualities of Windsor Lad. Smirke showed him the whip, and a final burst up the hill took him out of danger, and in the end he was leaving them all behind.

Flamenco was such a long way behind Colombo in the Guineas that it can be argued that Windsor Lad has still a long way to go to catch up the favourite. But as I have pointed out, the horse that has proved has tamina is never safe to leave out at Epsom, and although he will not be one of the most distinguished looking individuals in the Derby, there will be nothing in the field we know will stay better. In other words, Windsor Lad is going to be a big danger to Colombo and all of them.

Horses to Note

Valerius finished third three lengths behind Flamenco, and as he had every chance it hardly appears worth while considering him seriously for Epsom. For another course, probably Ascot, Black Devil is certainly worth keeping in mind. He was about the best looking horse in yesterday's field. For nearly a mile he was going as well as anything. Scornful is another nice colt who should be heard of a little later on.

Windsor Lad's victory was the third in succession for Lambourn horses, and Almond Hill made it four when she outstayed the Newmarket hope, Shalfleet, in the Shelford Plate. Papilla f. and Hoplite were the others, and although the draw may have made all the difference between them where the former and Broadcaster were concerned, Hoplite certainly completed Cottrill's double on merits.

Smart-Two-Year-Old

Maltravers continued the good work of Frank Butters's two-year-olds by winning the Spring Plate very easily from Sea Bequest after making the whole of the running. Mumtaz Begum, a daughter of the famous "Mumty," showed speed that suggests she will win on an easy course and it might be wise to forgive the well-backed Fairhaven this defeat. Lord Derby's colt did not begin as many of the others and was always in a hopeless chase.
