THE Northumberland Plate may have shed some of its old-time glory in the eyes of southerners but in the north-east in general and Newcastle in particular it is still a Derby day when the big handicap comes round. The race will attract nearly twenty runners, this afternoon, and it is not going to be an easy prize to win.

The one I hope to see equal to the task is Apple Peel, and even if he does not quite get there I feel sure he will give a very good account of himself. The two miles at Newcastle is a very testing gallop, but a horse that can win over a furlong further at Newbury and finish second over two and a quarter miles at Epsom, as Apple Peel has done, at least possesses the necessary qualifications.

Another point in favour of Apple Peel is that ne has not been out for the best part of a month, whereas several of his rivals may still be feeling the effects of their Ascot exertions. Rol de Paris has also been absent since Epsom, but his running there did not suggest that he should turn the tables on Apple Peel on the slightly altered weights, although the going was certainly against him on that occasion.

I have already mentioned the northern hopes in Lincrusta and the Scottish-trained Timbuc, but with the knowledge that Within the Law was not in luck's way at Ascot. I regard Lady Yule's horse as possibly Apple Peel's most dangerous rival. Within the Law gave a sparkling display in winning the Yorkshire Cup, and if Wells can ride him to-day as he did on that occasion he should at least get into the first three.

Berestoi Upset

Misanthrope looks nicely treated on his Manchester form, though in the case of Lord Harewood's horse his ability to stay two miles has to be taken on trust. With Fox up he will certainly be well ridden, as was the Lambourn colt Hoplite when he upset the general idea that the first Beeswing Plate was a good thing for Berestoi

Hoplite had a nice pull in the weights with the Middleham champion and Fox set about making the most of it immediately the gate went up. As it turned out, he was never headed. For the first half of the journey Nevett was content with last place in the small field. and although he picked up the others easily enough Hoplite was always going too well and stayed on to win in really good style.

Anaglypta's Win

Anaglypta, who belongs to Mr. S. Morris, an ex-Mayor of Doncaster, put up the best performance of the day in the Perkins Memorial Plate. The colt was conceding 20lb. to Blue Car and put in some good work to catch the Weyhill colt in the last furlong. Brownie also shaped well under a big weight and should be worth following in the North.

Brownie, like Berestoi, is trained by Dobson Peacock, whose first winner at the meeting "came from the clouds," The stable hopes were centred in Chichester Chimes filly for the Blagdon Plate, but the one to do the trick was Lent Lily filly, who was ridden by the stable apprentice. J. Smith. and started at 20 to 1
