WHITEPLAINS UPSETS FORM RUNNERS AT IN NORTH PLATE

Lament Just Beaten in a Fine Finish

"NEW" BRIGHTON

IT'S an old saying that everything comes to him who waits. Whiteplains had waited more than a year for the success that came his way in the Northumberlat. I Plate yesterday—to the confusion of the form book and the joy of the bookmakers. Once again it was the number of onc of the "25 to 1 others" that went into the frame, and once again blinkers—worm for the first time—helped to do the trick.

Whiteplains had run three times previously this year without makin; any snow. In the Ascot Stakes he was well behind Lament, who on that occasion was receiving 7lb. Yesterday the difference was increased by another 7lb in favour of Lament, so it was hardly to be wondered that the bookmakers were loudest in the cheering that greeted his short-head success at the expense of Lament. Neither Sir Woodman Burbidge, his owner, nor his trainer, Jack Jarvis, went to the meeting to see him run.

Last Stride Win

Mr. James de Rothschild's filly made a gallant attempt to lead all the way; indeed the only point where she was not in front was on the post, and it was practically in the last stride that E. Smith snatched the prize. Annihilation, favourite from start to finish, had every chance, and so too did Apple Peel, who stayed on just long enough to keep the disappointing Satsuma out of third place.

Heavy showers during the night were all against Within the Law, who simply must have hard ground. Lady Yule's Yorkshire Cup winner was never in the picture. Neither was Timbuc, whose owner, Lieutenant-Commander Leake, came by air from London to see the race and then flew on to Scotland to join his wife's birthday party in the evening.

The King's Second

The big crowd were all ready to cheer a royal victory when Mildred took the lead in the Angerton Plate, only to be disappointed when Seductive came on the scene. As the latter had shown her usefulness against Ballon Prince at Lewes it was a pretty good performance on the part of the King's filly to run her to a length, and on this form Mildred's wimning turn should not be long delayed.

Contrary to expectations Seductive was not favourite, but two of her stable companions were; and both were beaten. Aspiration, the first of them, was out of a place behind Sir Picton—another long-priced winner for E. Smith—and Strela could only get third to Fanny Adams in the Gibside Plate. As Akela literally ran away from Double Forte in the Durham Stakes it was a really disastrous day for favourites.

Blue Charm, who has the reputation of being the best two-year-old at Middleham, makes

Two runaway victories were gained by oddson favourites. Mumtaz Begum, a daughter of Mumtaz Mahal, found a course to her liking in the Shoreham Plate, and Nevertheless was an equally easy winner in the Southover Plate. The Aga Khan's two-year-old had run twice previously without success and she has probably inherited more speed from her dam than stamina from her sire Blenheim.
