By BOUVERIE CONGRATULATIONS were not lacking at Windsor on Saturday when the small but clever South African boy, Terry Ryan, won the Slough Selling Handicap on Verford.

Owner's Luck Mrs. Corlette Glorney certainly made a most judicious purchase when she gave 560 guineas for Effaceable after she had won at Lingfield in May of last year.

Miss Talbot bought Fordilia as a yearling at Newmarket for 680 guineas. When making her debut on One Thousand Guineas day Fordilia finished last of all in the race won by Gynerium, and she was again well beaten at the Newmarket Second Spring Meeting.

In practically every race at Redcar there was keen rivalry between northern and southern stables. Adonis did not make the long trip from Stockbridge in vain, for he won the valuable Foal Plate.

St. Leger Call-Over

What of the St. Leger position as it is left now? Colombo is likely to become rather easier in the market, but, fit and well, the bookmakers will not be taking any liberties with Lord Glanely's colt when a definite announcement is made regarding his jockey.

Windsor Lad, the St. Leger favourite, moved in good style when given a capital pace gallop over nine furlongs at Lambourn on Saturday in company with Bloat and Black Tulip.

Tiberius has been supported at times for the St. Leger. Sir A. Bailey's colt has had a nice rest since the Derby, and although he has a welter impost he should survive the test in the Foal Plate at Redcar to-day.
