Thus it appears all plain sailing for Lo Zingaro, who, as I have said, must beat such as Bridge Law and Fleetfoot to keep himself in the Doncaster limelight.

The Best Thing?

Call Bell, Lemniscus and Reveille are other runners from the stable, and I shall be very disappointed if the first-named at least does not give Richards a winning ride. Indeed, she looks the best thing of the day. Lemniscus also has a nice chance in the Friary Nursery, and although Marie Louise is well fancied I doubt that she will give the Beckhampton colt 4lb. if he does his best.

Present arrangements are that The Trend gelding goes for the Harrington Plate in pre-ference to a race at Brighton, and that being the case he should be too good for Reveille and the rest. This unnamed youngster won in very good style at Bath recently, and Lambourn opinion is emphatic that he is still on the upgrade.

Unlucky Come-Back

G. Nicoll had his first ride since his accident at Windsor on Eppie Adair colt in the Breeders' Foal Plate at Derby yesterday, and although his mount might not have beaten Annabel in any case, he would certainly have been close up with better luck in running.
