

Weston a genius in tight finish

—AND KEEPS HIS CAP ON

SANDOWN, Monday.

MINISTRONE, in a finish of heads and short-heads between five horses, was able to resist the late flourish of Buoyant and win the Lonsdale Handicap here this afternoon.

Buoyant was the last to join the group of four horses—Ministrone, Colchis, Roderick Dhu and Brasso—who had been fiercely disputing the lead for the last furlong.

Lord Derby, who has been paying his annual visit to a spa in Wales, was not here to witness the success of his three-year-old.

Had he been present he would certainly have congratulated Weston on riding a cool race rounded off by a brilliant finish.

There were moments in the start when I feared Tommy would never obtain a clear run.

Such situations evoke Weston's undoubted genius. The only surprise was that Lord Derby's white cap was still on his head at the finish!

Colchis and Brasso could have been only a matter of inches against Roderick Dhu, the official third. An Apple A Day once flattered, but his effort was of brief duration and left an impression that he does not really relish a hard-fought struggle. Satisfication had been the early leader, but I never noticed Foletta, The Beak or Blot.

FAVOURITE CAUGHT

JACK JARVIS provided his usual Sandown winner when Epilobeum, in the capable hands of Eph Smith, overhauled the favourite Lady Delhi to win the Maiden Plate by half a length. The winner was drawn nearer the stands side, but was chopped for speed and had to challenge in the middle of the course.

Weston completed a double when Snow White, fresh despite Lewis exertions, easily accounted for Bobby in the Barnard and Carlos in the Lubbock Sprint. She seemed the only member of the field able to accelerate in the last furlong.

EASIEST WINNER

ALL the seven winners were well backed, but only Gyroscope and Rossall actually started favourites. Moon Ray was saddled for the Lammes Stakes in preference to his handicap engagement, but was no match for Gyroscope, the easiest of winners.

Rossall was one of three successes gained by inmates of O. Bell's stable this afternoon. Nord Express outclassed Ripon rivals to win the Great St. Wilfrid Handicap by three lengths—a noteworthy performance.

Sirkin went to Derby to ride Nizami for his patron, but even this task was beyond the grey's ability. Templeman, with two winners, took training honours at Chepstow, where Golden Sovereign was not saddled in Nip Away's Summer Cup, in which Laureat II added yet another to his long list of seconds.

BRUCE HOBBS felt no ill effect of his ride on Poor Duke—his first since his accident last November—at Newton Abbot. Poor Duke finished fifth in a big field.
