THREE more weeks and we shall be summing-up ideas on the St. Leger. But it is difficult to work up much enthusiasm over the Doncaster classic yet awhile. It is however, good news to learn that Blue Peter continues to make such steady progress in his gallops.

There are seven meetings this week. There will be a higher standard of sport at Stockton on Wednesday and Thursday, and on Saturday attention will be focussed on Heliospolis, carrying Lord Derby's colours in the Hyperion Stakes at Hurst Park.

The St. Leger is decided on September 6, and a pallo at Hurst Park will be useful. Other Doncaster candidates engaged at the end of the week are Atout Maître, Fairchance and Galatea II.

Work with its Ebor Handicap, follows Hurst Park, and then we have Manchester with the Prince Edward Handicap. Acceptances for these two races are due to-morrow.

Best bet for the Breeders' Foal Plate at Nottingham to-day may be Prince Tetra. It was only by a short head that he was beaten by Battling Jean at Doncaster, and he should give his backers another good run.

Major Brackey's Chance

Major Brackey is worth an interest in connection with the Nottinghamshire Handicap. This colt was taking on different company in the Derby and Ascot Gold Vase.

Reports are favourable to the chance of Rossilver in the Redcar Handicap. The son of Rose Prince figured with credit behind Good Fare at Nottingham and will only have to do as well here to be in the thick of the fighting.

Saint Andrews II has been sent from Epsom for the Dormanstown Plate. An easy winner of the Brighton Cup last Wednesday, he should give another promising display.

Epsom advices are to the effect that Poetic Licence is expected to win the Kent Handicap at Folkestone. He disappointed at Woivershampston a fortnight ago, but was giving a lot of weight to Braydore.

LARKIN'S VICTORY

BAILEY IF ever any one cycle race could have settled the much-discussed question of "Who is the best fifty miler?" it should have been yesterday's Barnsley race, for every medium distance crack in the country had entered. London had sent the fifty miles competition record holder L. Thorpe, a strong team from the Norwood Paragon, and Eddie Mills (Addiscombe), Yorkshire had Eddie Larkin, Alf Martin, Ron Kitching, Reuben Firth and Norman Hey; Manchester was represented by Eddie Leepe and F. Butterworth; and Stockton by Percy Howes.

Eddie Larkin, of the famous Monckton Colliery team, was fastest. He clocked 2h. 5m. 30s.—two minutes too fast for the rest. An epidemic of tyre trouble paid to the chanciness of many, including Clamp, but it is doubtful whether any of them would have equalled the Yorkshire pit-boy's time. Eddie Mills (London) was second (2h. 7m. 30s.). Next places went to Reuben Firth (Bronte) (2h. 8m. 7s.); A. Duckworth (West Bradford) (2h. 9m. 18s.); J. G. Bell (Liverpool Minty) (2h. 9m. 45s.). With an allowance of 9 1/2 minutes Bell also won the handicap prize. In the Brixton C.C. 100kms. race at Brookland, Ernie Jones (Fountain C.C.) won the lap prize by leading for eleven of the laps. Then, in the final sprint, he won by a length from D. K. Swan (Clarencourt).

By THE HURDLER FOUR good bitches are among the six runners in the principal race at Harringay to-night. They are Ganges River, Alder Tree, Bole and Bon Bouche. It promises to be a very close race and I think Ganges River will beat Bole. This should make a good each-way forecast.

Granada Royalist is generally slow in getting into his stride, but he is a strong finisher and many beat Dusty Boy II. As a general rule, it is safer to support fast starters, as these have a better chance of missing first-bend collisions, but with the fairly long run-up to the finishing line at Harringay strong-finishing dogs have a better chance than at most other tracks.
