FOLKESTONE RACES OFF, BUT ALL CLEAR FOR MANCHESTER

FOLKESTONE Races, which were to have taken place to-day and to-morrow, have been abandoned. It is understood that the abandonment was made because of the curtailment of railway facilities necessitated by the decision to evacuate children from London and other centres.

With Folkestone "off," Manchester is left with the distinction of staging the season's first nursery—as two-year-old handicaps are designated. For some reason there is not a race of this type on the first day's card, in which the Breeders' Foal Plate is the chief event. It is likely to be won by Trois Pistoles, a very smart youngster, trained by Harry Peacock, who is reported back to his very best form. Danger is the Aga Khan's Nizami.

Robert E. Lee Beaten

Few surprises of recent weeks have come up to the defeat of Robert E. Lee's in his All-Richards match with Hyland Brume at Brighton yesterday.

Lord Carnarvon's American-bred colt had won all his previous races in such style that odds of 4 to 1 were laid on Gordon beating his brother to make it six off the reel.

Chief, however, had other ideas than waiting for the Robert E. Lee. Hyland Brume has always been a speedy customer. The sharp course suited him down to the ground, and while onlookers were rubbing their eyes Lord Elrst's colt strolled home three lengths in front of the supposed certainty.

All the other favourites shared the fate of Robert E. Lee, among them three more of Gordon's mounts, Burytown, Sugar Lady and Sil vous Platt, who all got so near and yet so far.

Atlanta also finished second in her attempt to win the Palace Handicap. Again it was a desperately close call with the scales turned in favour of King's Joy by Littlewood's 5lb. allowance.

Norman Scobie brought off a treble at Haydock with Suez, Zoo and Talhoo, the last-named of which has now won six times off the reel.
