THE METHOD: We use the finest fake fur or hair available. It's not all blotched up or clotty & it WON'T FALL OFF A WEEK LATER. Others have had this problem but we, never. It LOOKS real. I put hair right on over the old mane & forelock, leaving no loose ends. It looks like it grew right out of the model. For tails there are 2 ways: for chinas or plastics I can apply hair right to the old tail, or for plastics such as Broyers I can remove the old tail & put on a new hair one with a wire base. This method is really great because you can have it shorter or longer than the old one & it makes for a much-better look. This way enables you to change the position of the tail anytime you want, combed out for 1 pic, blowing for another.
