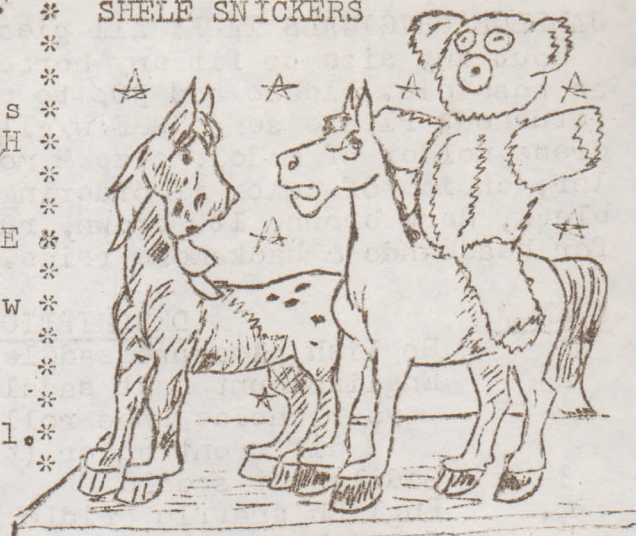


QUARTER HORSE CHATTER

C=No Ch/Res. but less than 4 blues in ea. category but more than 2 blues.... <u>FEE</u> :25¢ per horse per class. <u>DEADLINE</u> : Nov. 25th! <u>AWARDS</u> : Money, trophies/ribbons to Top Ten Winners ONLY. ENTRIES must be in by Dec. 9th. Purebreds ONLY. Each entry must be accompanied by his/her show credentials won up to show deadline. SASE req. for return of pix. I'll provide SASE for awards.
